A staggering 74% of women (compared to 71% of men) are playing mobile games, once - several times per day; with more than 67% quoting mobile gaming as a vital part of 'me time', a means to relax and unwind, according to a global survey by GameHouse.



Women's 'Me Time' Resides on Mobile. For more than 70% of Women, Mobile Gaming Provides the Key Means to Relax and Unwind


Goal

Over 800 US and UK consumers aged 18 yrs+ were surveyed about their interests, hobbies and passions, how they spend their 'me time', what creates the most valuable 'me time' experience and how their mobile devices and mobile gaming factor into this. The survey was carried out on an external market research provider platform, Pollfish,that has access to over 250 million+ consumers around the world.




Distribution by gender and country






Age distrubution




Relationship status







'Me time'

'Me time' for women represents time for themselves, quoting "time that is just for me doing something I love and not being stressed out or doing things for others" or just time they can decide to do nothing at all, quoting "time where I don't have to think about or do anything for anyone else. I can focus on what I like to do, or do nothing at all". 46% percent of women aged 18 yrs+ feel they don't get enough or any 'me time', with just 32% saying they get an average amount. Within this 60% of 35-44 year olds say they don't get enough or any 'me time'. Women in general mostly get their 'me time' in the evenings or weekends. Kids play a bigger role in when women get their me time, quoting "I get my me time when the kids go to bed", while for men, kids are mentioned almost 7 times less.

How do you feel about the amount of "me time" that you get?




How do you feel about the amount of "me time" that you get? (female only, by age)

When do you usually get your "me time"? (male)








34% of women say that they sometimes feel guilty about taking their 'me time'; with 15% frequently or always feeling guilty, compared to just 7% of men. Interestingly, guilt around spending time on their mobile device almost doubles between US and UK women, at UK - 21% feeling guilty, US - 10%.




Please rate the following statement: "I feel guilty when taking my "me time" (female only, UK vs US)






How do you feel when you spend time on your mobile device? (female vs male)



How do you feel when you spend time on your mobile device? (female only; UK vs US)






Where watching TV and listening to music remain big hitters for women wanting to switch off and take time for themselves, today 67% of women 18 yrs+ are playing games and mobile games during their 'me time', with an astounding 29% quoting playing games as their favorite way to spend time alone, unwind and relax.

Within this:

- 35 44 yr olds, 59.7% of respondents spend their 'me time' listening to music, 33.1% playing games, 21% doing DIY
- 45 54 yr olds 24.7% enjoy playing games
- 55 64 21.1% enjoy playing games in their 'me time'
- Amongst all means of relaxation and entertainment, for women aged 18 yrs+, gaming ranked the sixth most popular way to relax and unwind.











People who play mobile or other video games during their me time (UK vs US)



People who play mobile or other video games during their me time (by age)




Why do you play mobile or other video games? (female vs male)




In terms of overall areas of interest, cooking remains the most popular for women across the globe; with a considerable 57% favoring this. Family and relationships remain an important focus for over 53%, and, for 51%, eating out is the pastime of choice. Watching TV shows and movies ranks in fourth position, with 48% of women favoring this. When asked how they like to spend their time on mobile, women like to focus on social media (76%), shopping (66%) and communicating with friends and family (60%).



Most enjoyed activities on mobile device (female only, UK vs US)




Mobile remains the most popular gaming platform for women, with 41.9% women playing games on Android and 53.9% on iPhone.

Which device, or devices do you use to play your games the most? (female vs male)










Please rate the following statement: "I feel guilty while playing mobile or other video games" (female only, by age)







At what time of the day do you prefer to play games? (female vs male)




At what time of the day do you prefer to play games? (female only, UK vs US)






When do you prefer to play mobile or other video games the most? (female vs male)




When do you prefer to play mobile or other video games the most? (female only, UK vs US))






On average, how often do you play mobile or other video games? (female vs male)




At what time of the day do you prefer to play games? (female only, UK vs US)
