HOW DO YOU KNOW WHEN THE VERB IS REFLEXIVE?

When the letters _____ are attached to the end of a verb, it means that it is reflexive.

You've actually used reflexive verbs before... even from the first day of Spanish class. Each time you answer the question, **¿Como te llamas?** (*What is your name?*) and responded with **Me llamo** (*My name is...*) you were actually using the reflexive verb _____.

WHAT IS SPECIAL ABOUT REFLEXIVE VERBS?

In Spanish, these verbs need an extra part that comes _____ the conjugated verb.
This is called the _____.

In other words, in Spanish, when you talk about an action being performed on yourself or someone else, you use a reflexive _____ and a reflexive _____.

CONFUSED?! THAT'S OKAY.... HERE IS ANOTHER WAY TO THINK ABOUT IT...

In English we say: "I wake up. I get out of bed and go to the bathroom. In the bathroom I wash my face..." THINK about it – **Who does the action? Who receives the action?**

In English we COULD say: "I wake _____ up. I get _____ out of bed and go to the bathroom.

But we don't! WHY NOT, MINOT? Because it's implied that when you say: "I wash my face" you're doing it to yourself. But in SPANISH, we need to specify **who** you are doing the action to.

STEP 3: CONJUGATE THE VERB NORMALLY (REMOVE THE _____, ADD THE NEW _____)

*NOTE: THE CONJUGATIONS OF REFLEXIVE VERBS FOLLOW THE NORMAL CONJUGATION PATTERNS OF _____, _____, _____ VERBS EXCEPT IF THEY ARE _____ VERBS.
