Accessory Fitting Courses

The Motor Trade Association of Western Australia (MTA WA) is the peak industry group for the WA automotive industry who are dedicated to ensuring a thriving industry through training and skill set development. The Association delivers vocational and post-trade training for automotive tradespeople, apprentices, and trainees to develop their skills and achieve qualifications to enable them to apply for their Motor Vehicle Repairer's certificates in WA. Motor Vehicle Repairer's certificates are a requirement in Western Australia under the Motor Vehicle Repairers Act 2003.

Accessory Fitting Courses

The Accessory Fitting Courses have been designed to allow students to develop the underpinning knowledge required to demonstrate an understanding of the requirements and legislation of a parts accessory fitter in Western Australia. This course is offered through three pathways; Mechanical, Electrical or a combination of both. All candidates that successfully complete any of the courses will receive a certificate of completion. This certificate is recognised by DMIRS for candidates to successfully apply for the relevant class of repair work.

Course Delivery

Course delivery is blended with an online component, evidence gathering via a logbook and a practical assessment. Once enrolled the course is available for 12 months to allow you to complete the online component, gather sufficient evidence and pass a practical assessment.

The online component of the course is made up of a set of modules each with their own short quiz. Once all modules are complete there is a final exam drawing from all modules in the course.

Course Options;

Mechanical Accessory Fitting Course

Course consists of 6 modules

Safety & Environment, Tools & Equipment, Communications & Parts Selection, Final Driveline & Brakes, Steering & Suspension, Remove & Refit Accessories comprises of fitting mechanical accessories that may not come standard on a vehicle., Examples of content covered fitting bull bars; tow bars; roof racks.

Electrical Accessory Fitting Course

Course consists of 4 modules

Safety & Environment, Mechanical Tools & Equipment, Communications & Parts Selection, Electrical Accessories - comprises of fitting electrical accessories that may not come standard on a vehicle. Examples of content covers: wiring for tow bar; installation of a refrigerator/12 outlet; caravan 12 volt accessories; car/caravan vehicle spotlights; or sets of lights.

Parts Accessory Fitting Course

A combination of both the Mechanical and Electrical Accessory Fitting Courses consisting of 7 modules.

Safety and Environment, Tools & Equipment, Communication and Parts Selection, Driveline & Brakes, Steering & Suspension, Electrical Accessories, Remove & Refit Accessories.
