

## Viewer Guide Session 6

## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. What life experiences came to mind as you listened to Pastor Rick's message? Does anyone have a story to share of a time when God delivered you from a dead end?
- 2. How does remembering who God is and what he can do help you as you wait for his deliverance?
- 3. What promises from God encourage you when you are at a dead end?
- 4. What is the most meaningful lesson you have learned in this study? What step will you take today to start to apply that lesson in your life?

## **Prayer Direction**

If you are in the dead-end phase of faith, call on the Lord as your Deliverer (see Psalm 18:2). Ask him to restore your hope and trust in him and to make a way where there is no way. Before you pray for each other's requests, thank God for the lessons in faith that he has taught you through this study.

## **Putting It into Practice**

Your story of faith can change someone else's life. Who do you know who needs to hear about the six phases of faith? Make a plan to share with them the faith-building lessons you have learned through this study.

The ultimate form of faith is thanking God in advance for what you are presently asking him to do. If you thank him after he has answered your prayer, that is not faith but gratitude. When you're at a dead end, choose to thank God that the answer is already on the way.
