SECONDARY MICROPLASTICS ARE TINY PLASTIC PIECES THAT FORM WHEN LARGER PLASTICS BREAK DOWN.

MICROPLASTICS HAVE BEEN NOW DOCUMENTED PRETTY MUCH EVERYWHERE ON THE PLANET.

MICROPLASTICS MOVE THROUGH THE FOOD CHAIN, STARTING WITH ZOOPLANKTON, THEN FISH AND OTHER SEAFOOD, EVENTUALLY ENDING UP ON OUR PLATES.
