



















































































































# THINKING OF YOU

"I mean," replied Judy in her silkiest tone, "that while you've been so busy staring at that girl by the drinking fountain, the boy she's with has been busy staring at me!"





"Not on your life!" growled Oogie. "This time I'm thinking of myself! If you think I'm going to let that guy have a chance with you, you've got emother thought coming!"




















































































