

Worship Reunites Us with One

Worship is what I live for. When you start to understand it from the “spiritual dimension”, you'll understand why it's so important. Did you know in the Bible, that's the only thing God looks for? He doesn't look for anyone else but worshipers. He says something very interesting:

John 4:23

“God is looking for worshipers who worship Him in spirit and truth;”

Now, that sounds very strange because “spirit” and “truth” are spiritual words. Everything Jesus said is “spirit” and “truth”, which means His Word is “spirit and “truth”. (see *John 6:63*)

“God is Spirit.” (see *John 4:24*)

You and I were made in His image. (see *Genesis 1:26*)

That makes you spirit. But the truth is, we are “one”. Now, that's the hardest concept to understand in the natural. Because everyone in this dimension is promoted for their separation and their differences. And that's why God said, “you must be one.” (see *John 17:21*)

Jesus said, *“The Father and Me are One.”* (see *John 10:30*)

It also says in **John 1:1** that *“Jesus is the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word is God.”*

John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

I'm going to read this verse in **John 17** so it can sink in.

John 17:17

“Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.”

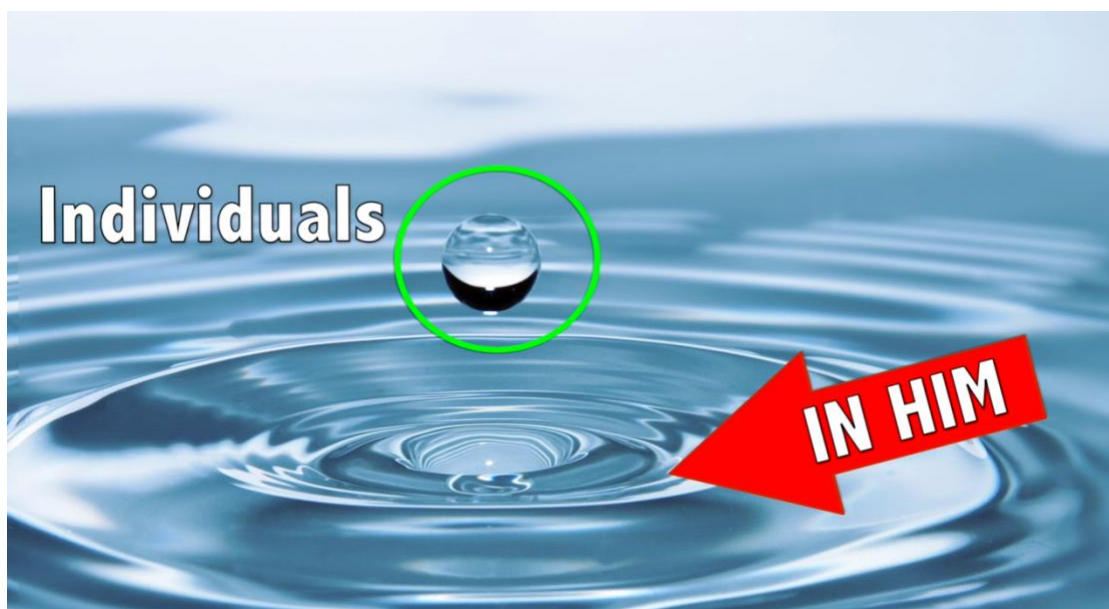
God is looking for someone who is worshiping in spirit and Christ (Word). If the Word is Truth and Jesus is the Word, then that means God is saying, *“You need to know the Truth. You need to know the Word, not philosophy, not doctrine. You need to know Him (Christ).”*

You see, the problem that we have is we know about Jesus of Nazareth, but we have never met the resurrected Christ, because that requires “spirit to Spirit”, and worship is the avenue to meet Him spirit to Spirit.

Are you following what I'm saying?

There's not any greater opportunity to meet Spirit than in worship because you lose your individuality and become one.

See the image of the water in the drop. This “wave” is who we are “in Him”.



This “drop” is what we become when we become “individuals”.

Worship reunites you with One.



Now look at this picture with “the man in the bubble”.



When we create our individuality, that's where we create our separation and our image.

You can't worship Him in separation (with our image) as an individual.

Most people try to worship God as an individual. That vibration never reaches the frequency of the Spirit. And most people try to pray from this position of separation. **You're not an individual, you are “one in Him” before the foundation of the world.**

When you lose who you think you are, you now have the attention of your Heavenly Father.

Are you following me?

It sounds like something impossible to do, but worship gives you those opportunities, because if you understand that you are really a spirit and all you are is frequencies, you'll understand that “that frequency” you have as an “individual” will never touch the heart of God. But because God loves you, unconditionally, He takes you through circumstances and events in your life until you say, *“Okay, I lose my image, I'm ready to meet You face to face.”*

How many of you have been through situations and circumstances in your life? Is there anyone that hasn't? (Is a better question). Because that's the place God is trying to “draw you out of your illusion” of this reality into the reality of the spirit dimension. And that's what people are afraid of. “Fear is what keeps you an individual.”

Are you ready to meet your Heavenly Father face to face? Let's stand and worship. In this worship time you're going to hear frequencies from our special guests that will help you to "remove your image". Because "you are one", and you don't care what you sound like, you don't care who's beside you, you just want to touch the Father's heart.

Because He loves us so much, He is anxious to meet you face to face.
