The Foundation of the Kingdom Remembering Our Future Series – Session 4 | English Transcript – Emerson Ferrell

I was thinking the other day how we always want to hurry up and change the condition we are in at the present time. And the Lord reminded me that **the** conditions are the result of what we need.

We are in *this place* in *this time* for a particular reason and the more we pay attention to *this present time*, *this present second*, the more we start to expand our understanding of everything that our life is about.

In nature, there's not one thing that is *not necessary* for the continuation of nature. Everything perpetuates the next thing. So, the Lord says, "if you step back and you just look at where you are right now, you'll get a memory of where you were in the **origin of your beginning**."

It's because our minds are so active and always moving that we stir up everything that has been placed in us before the foundation of the world. The thoughts that try to distract you are the ones you're most concerned and focused on in on your life. That's what's draining your energy and your spiritual awareness.

So, I want you to close your eyes. And now for the next five minutes, just be conscious of the way you're breathing. Notice the stillness that starts to come over your body. Notice the patterns that are being formed on your optical nerve in the back of your brain. You are light. There is light, even with your eyes closed inside of you. I want you to see that light. Observe your breathing. Feel the stillness. Feel the peace. See the colors inside of you. Feel the peace. Observe how your breath becomes slower. Observe how the light becomes brighter. Are you seeing the gold inside of that light? Are you seeing the veins inside that light? That's your glory. That's who you are.

Observe the thoughts trying to distract you. Focus on your breathing. You are the light that you are seeing. Allow it to go into every cell inside your body. Allow that gold to enter into your blood. Watch it go through your body, through your heart. Look at the wholeness inside you. Allow your heart to be the master of your thoughts. Pay attention to the way the blood is pumping, to rhythm with your breathing. Listen to the quiet that is inside of you. Become familiar with this sound. Light has a sound. That's the light from your heart. It's renewing your cells. It's changing your focus, your focus on the wholeness. No division. You are spirit.

That *peace* is like a river flowing through your being. Surrender to that peace. See yourself totally complete, lacking nothing. Filled with all the goodness of the Spirit. You're lacking nothing. Your health, your healing, it's all in you. You're separated from the external being your governor. Now you're in touch with the *real you*. This is the secret place. This is where you come to meet with your King of kings. Whenever your external overwhelms, this is the place you come. There's just waves of His glory in this place and this is what increases that electromagnetic field around you. This becomes your antenna to attract more and more of His glory. But you're responsible for building that antenna by making the time to be alone with Him. Do not forsake what He's given you. This is precious and this is for those who know Him. And the adventure and the journey "never ends," so you have to let go of everything that distracts you and enter into this *secret place*.

I hope you'll take advantage of every day to come into the presence of God. You control your circumstances by the place you begin your day. If your day begins in the presence of God, and you learn how to let go and stop trying to be in control, God will bring you everything you need for every day. But the minute you start to become stressed or worrying about the past, you remove God from doing what He wants to do for you.

When they talk about the foundation of the world, what was that *foundation* of the world?

The Foundation of the World:

- We know it was death.
- We know that it was using our senses to be our god.
- And we know it was fear.

This is the foundation of the world. They all happen simultaneously. They're not linear, they're not horizontal. It's a **simultaneous mentality**.

We use our senses to determine what is our enemy in the environment. What threatens us? And the threat is: "it's going to take away my control." Senses means "control", and it's all about saving yourself and the fear of dying.

When Jesus came, He was preaching the Kingdom. What is the **foundation** of the Kingdom?

He gives us that in **Matthew 5:3**

"Blessed are those who recognize they are spiritually helpless, for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to them."

Matthew 5:10

"Blessed are those who are persecuted for doing what God approves of, for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to them."

We call this the Beatitudes. And Jesus was coming, and He was showing the people by talking about these particular Beatitudes that "He is the Kingdom." And His behavior reflected "who He was". These are the behaviors, beginning in verse 4.

Matthew 5:4-9

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

Blessed are those who are gentle (meek), for they will inherit the earth.

Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for God's approval, for they will be satisfied.

Blessed are those who show mercy, for they will be treated mercifully. Blessed are those whose thoughts are pure, for they will see God. Blessed are those who make peace, for they will be called God's children."

So, we see the foundation of the Kingdom of God is "Jesus, The Christ." Now, the *Christ is the resurrected Jesus*. When He is giving these beatitudes, He is talking about Himself, so when He came and started to preach "The Kingdom," He was fulfilling what the prophets in the old covenant were saying. Isaiah and all the Old Testament prophets were prophesying, "the Messiah is coming!" Because when He comes, He is going to establish the Kingdom of God.

So, Christ came and He put the **foundation of the Kingdom** in these verses in Matthew 5. This is really important for us to understand. Because we read those things and we're going, "How can we act like this?" Nobody likes to be treated ungodly around people and persecuted. No body likes their person insulted and treated badly. Jesus did. Jesus went through all the things He's talking about in those verses.

But it was very interesting that those two verses in verse 3 and verse 10 are the ones that say *that's what gives you the Kingdom*, because that is the picture of the resurrected Christ.

Let's read it again, Matthew 5:3

Blessed are those who recognize they are spiritually helpless (poor in spirit), for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to them.

That's the one that says, "poor in spirit" in many translations. And in verse 10.

Matthew 5:10

"Blessed are those who are persecuted for doing what God approves of, for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to them."

So, when you have "that" as your **foundation**, that means you are recognizing the resurrected Christ, and you live in that spiritual dimension. That spiritual dimension is separated from the physical world system.

Jesus said many times that, "If you follow Me, you will not taste death", which is one of the major principles of the Kingdom of this World. His behavior reflected His resurrection. Let's read those verses again. This is really good for you to know. See, you're in the world, but you're not of it. Your behavior has to reflect the resurrected Christ. So, you mourn with those that are in the mourning. And in verse 5, it says: "if you're gentle, you will inherit the earth." In another translation it says, "The meek will inherit the earth."

So, you walk on this planet as if you are nurturing the planet everywhere you go with your spirit.

Meek people don't try to take, they give. They would rather leave something than take something. And the Earth opens its mouth to those people. It recognizes the meek that are on this earth. And those that are hungry and are thirsty for more of God, they're not interested in being exalted or finding a place where they don't have to learn anymore. They don't have to find some kind of false system that makes them feel like they're protected. They are hungry for God. They're never satisfied. They want more. Those people will be filled with the revelation of Christ.

But those that are satisfied with their theologies and doctrines, the Holy spirit can't give you anymore because you feel like you're satisfied.

And it says:

Matthew 5:7

"Blessed are those who show mercy, for they will be treated mercifully."

So, rather than point your finger and condemn, you reserve that for God. You are merciful where you can be merciful. And I've learned that if I can't be merciful, I remove myself from the situation. And I also learned that any kind of thought that condemns or exalts me separates me from the revelation and the presence of God. But that comes with practice of *being conscious* of "what you think" and "why you think it".

Most times the reason we think the thoughts we do "is to protect" the image we've created. That image is what "we think" insulates us from God's judgment.

Matthew 5:8

"Blessed are those whose thoughts are pure, for they will see God."

When you are conscious of Christ, you haven't made the effort to filter what is pure. Be *conscious* of "how you think," "why you think," and those kinds of things. Be *conscious* of "what" in the "external" triggers what thought?

You see, there are thoughts that come from the external, and there's thoughts that come from the internal. Everything that comes from the external triggers a chemical reaction inside of your being. The thoughts that come from internal is what purifies your heart. Did you hear me?

But you have to understand which is which, because you don't control what comes on from the inside, you control what comes from the outside. What's inside you is the Spirit of Christ, and it says in the Old Testament, "My thoughts of you are for good." (see Jeremiah 29:11)

So, is Christ in you? Then it is His thoughts that are coming up and is purifying you. But most times we don't hear those thoughts because we're so consumed by the **external and the noise inside of us**.

Matthew 5:9

"Blessed are those who make peace, for they will be called God's children."

How many of you see children making peace with one another? They're fast to forgive one another. They learn to be mean when they go to school and other things, but most of the time they want to hug one another. They'd rather have friends than enemies. That's how children are born. That's what God calls His children.

Let's read a verse that I put down here from the Gospel of Thomas.

Gospel of Thomas, saying 3

Jesus said, "If those who lead you say to you, 'See, the Kingdom is in the sky,' then the birds of the sky will precede you. If they say to you, 'It is in the sea,' (talking about the kingdom) then the fish will precede you. Rather, the Kingdom is inside of you, and it is outside of you. When you come to know yourselves, then you will become known, and you will realize that it is you who are the sons of the living Father."

Remember, if you know the Kingdom is inside of you, you begin to change what is outside of you. That's why Thomas is talking like this.

Gospel of Thomas, saying 3 (continued)

"But if you will not know yourselves, you dwell in poverty, and it is you who are that poverty."

You dwell in what you create. We don't see things the way they are we see things the way we are.

Did you hear me?

We don't see things the way they are. We see things the way we are.

So, if you're seeing everything around you as an enemy, as death, as fearful, then that's what "you are" inside. We have the creation of God in us that can create what we see. Are you happy being unhappy? No. So change the way you see. How do you do that? Glad you asked. Now I get to show you.

Here's another verse from Thomas.

Gospel of Thomas, saying 70

Jesus said, "That which you have will save you if you bring it forth from yourselves. That which you do not have within you will kill you if you do not have it within you."

You have it in you, so if you **bring it forth** it will save you, but if you continue to see: "everything is in chaos, in sickness, and disease," then that's what's going on inside you.

We said that **the control** comes from the senses in the foundation of the world.

If you read **Proverb 6:16-19**, you'll see...

These are six things that Lord hates, seven that are detestable to Him: Arrogant eyes, a lying tongue, hands that will kill innocent people, a mind devising wicked plans, feet that are quick to do wrong.

So, these are the behaviors of those who operate from the kingdom of this world. So those are the things that want to protect you, those are the senses,

that's why you use them. They produce these limited emotions that attach us to the fears that are on the inside of us. See, when we have an image of something that is our enemy or can harm us, we match that image with chemistry inside of us. That image builds a foundational place inside of our state of being. That state of being creates our **personality** and our **personal reality**.

So, we don't operate according to who we are, we operate according to the images we've created. And we spend the rest of our waking life trying to protect that image that we formed from the limited emotions.

You see, "separation" and "limited emotions" results in what the world calls karma. But the karma is the term the world uses, the Bible says it is "sowing and reaping".

Jesus said in John 12:48,

"Those who reject Me by not accepting what I say have a judge appointed for them. The words that I have spoken will judge them on the last day."

The words that Jesus spoke carried the frequency that God released when He said, "Light be." (see Genesis 1:3)

That was the First Day Light, but it also carried the love of God through every dimension into the earth. I think we spoke last time about every dimension was created with the different powers and principalities and angels.

And that word keeps everything in order in every dimension. And it's the Light of God, and the word of God, which is Christ.

So, the order that's in this earth is spoken by Jesus while He was on the planet. Actually, it's re-spoken. It was spoken *before the foundation of the world*.

So, when Jesus said, "You're not going to be punished by Me, You are punished because you've rejected Me."

So, sin is rejecting Christ. You're not punished for your sins. You're punished by your sins. It's your choice.

Every time we make a choice we make a decision, and that decision will bless us as it says in the beatitudes, or it will curse us because we're following the foundation of this world's system.

Are you following me? We're talking about how the different dimensions created from the Light of God, also created the different angelic hosts.

Turn to 2 Peter 2:4-5

For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment; and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteous, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;

And jump down to 2 Peter 2:9

Then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment.

So, Peter is talking about something that happened before the second Earth, or after the flood, when all of the angels were taken into hell to be judged.

Now, turn over to 1 Peter 3:18-19

For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison.

Another translation says, "In that state, He also went and made a proclamation to the spirits in prison."

Now this is really important to see:

When He came as Jesus of Nazareth, what did He preach? He preached the Kingdom of God.

When He went into the spiritual dimensions, what did He do? **He made a proclamation.** I'm telling you, that's how we need to conduct our lives today.

As sure as I'm standing here, I'm telling you, by the Spirit, you can make a proclamation and change your tomorrow.

We're not following the Jesus of Nazareth. We're living in the resurrected Christ who has already judged all of the unrighteousness in the earth in every dimension.

When you stand in that revelation, then you can make a proclamation.

I make a proclamation to all the unrighteousness that's operating in the earth today. Your time is up. You're going to be removed.

A resurrected Christ is now operating with the knowledge of the resurrection. He has paid the price for all unrighteousness, for all sin, and now righteousness reigns.

The voices of unrighteousness are silenced. The voices of sickness and disease are silenced. From this day forward, the proclamation of the resurrected Christ is in the land.

We're done with it. It's over. This is a new day. The last day is over.

This is a new day. The proclamation of the Resurrected Christ is in the land. It's in your heart. It's in your mind. It's changing the way you believe.

You're no longer a slave or a victim. You hear me? You're a creator of what you are and what you see. You're no longer a victim.

Make that proclamation wherever you are and don't allow your thoughts to go back and retrace any thinking about the past!

Something happened. Something happened.

I want you to spend every day in the presence of God. Before you eat, before you drink, before you do anything, you spend time in the presence with God. And then start seeing things the way you are from *the inside of the resurrected Christ*.

Quit allowing your circumstances to be your projector. Every time you feel like you're losing that position, take a step back and close your eyes and get back into His presence.

You're a creator.

Make a proclamation every day as a resurrected Christ. Live in the Resurrected Christ. Don't allow anything to change that condition or position. I hope you'll get this message out to everyone. This will really change your life.
