
Guide for Accessing Safety Data Sheets (SDS) on the Chemwatch SmartSuite app




Chemwatch SmartSuite

The MTA WA now provides access to the Chemwatch database of SDS to members, apprentices and trainees. This can be accessed on a computer, using your phone's web browser, or via the SmartSuite app, which is available on both Apple and Android.


To get started, download "Chemwatch Mobile SmartSuite" from the Play Store/App Store.



Log in using the details provided when you set up your Chemwatch profile with The MTA WA.




Once logged in, you will have access to your workplace's hazardous substance register You will need to synchronise your device (download the register) to view these folders.







The app's memory use can be limited/cleared through the settings menu if required.




Use the search function to find SDS quickly, the search can be set to your own register (Own) or the (Full) Chemwatch database.





When searching the full database, it is recommended to filter your search by country (Australia).





Selecting the product from the search results brings up the product's full SDS. For quick reference, most products have a "mini" version, which displays the most important information on a single page. This can be accessed by tapping the 3 dots at the top of the page and selecting MINI
