

# AUR21920 CERTIFICATE II IN AUTOMOTIVE TYRE SERVICING TECHNOLOGY



### **RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING**

#### **Course Overview**

MTA WA Training offers the Certificate II in Automotive Tyre Servicing Technology (AUR21920) qualification through a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) pathway. Learners will be provided with the opportunity to confirm their skills and knowledge in the tyre fitting industry. All successful learners will be issued a nationally accredited qualification recognised by all states in Australia. All learners issued with the qualification will be able to apply for a relevant WA Motor Vehicle Repairer's Licence. Core skills assessed during the process will include safe work practices, and light vehicle tyre removal, inspection, repairing, replacing and balancing. Other key skills include environmental practices, troubleshooting, workshop tooling and communication skills with fellow staff and customers. The remaining units of competency must be chosen by the learners to reflect the work they are currently undertaking and is offered via 2 options as listed below:

#### **OPTION**

- A) Wheel Aligning with Steering & Suspension inspections or
- B) Heavy Vehicle Tyres

### **Learning Outcomes**

To be awarded the AUR21920 Certificate II in Automotive Tyre Servicing Technology, learners must successfully complete 14 units of competency. This is made up of 4 core (C) units, 3 specialist elective units (SE) and 7 elective units (E).

#### Duration

This qualification is attained through an assessment only pathway (RPL) with an allowance of 12 months to complete, however the qualification can be attained in a much shorter time.

### **Mode of Delivery**

Learners will be required to provide evidence of their competence for all units in all sections they have opted to complete. This evidence portfolio and answering some knowledge questions, as well as demonstrating their skills in front of an assessor.

Learners will need to complete the mandatory essential units. They will then be required to choose and compete either Option A or Option B depending on their work skills and knowledge. Option A is focused on Steering, Suspension and Wheel Alignment. Option B is focused on Heavy Vehicle Tyres. A candidate can choose to complete both options if they are in a workplace that covers all aspects of the assessment and are able to supply the required evidence.

This qualification is fully delivered through a Recognition of Prior Learning Pathway.
