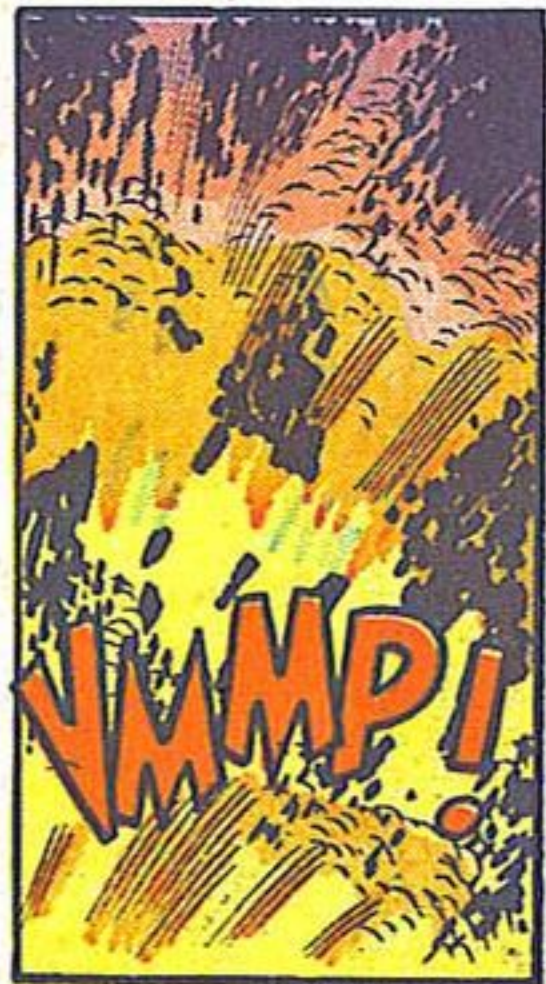
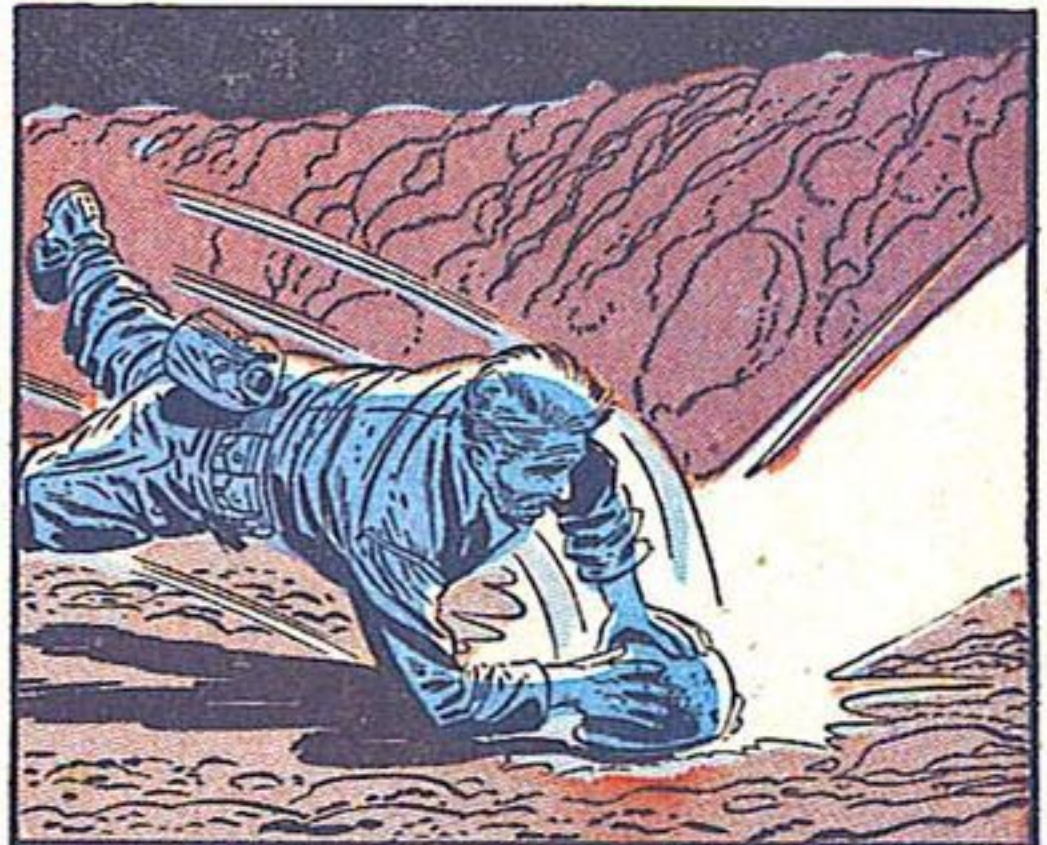
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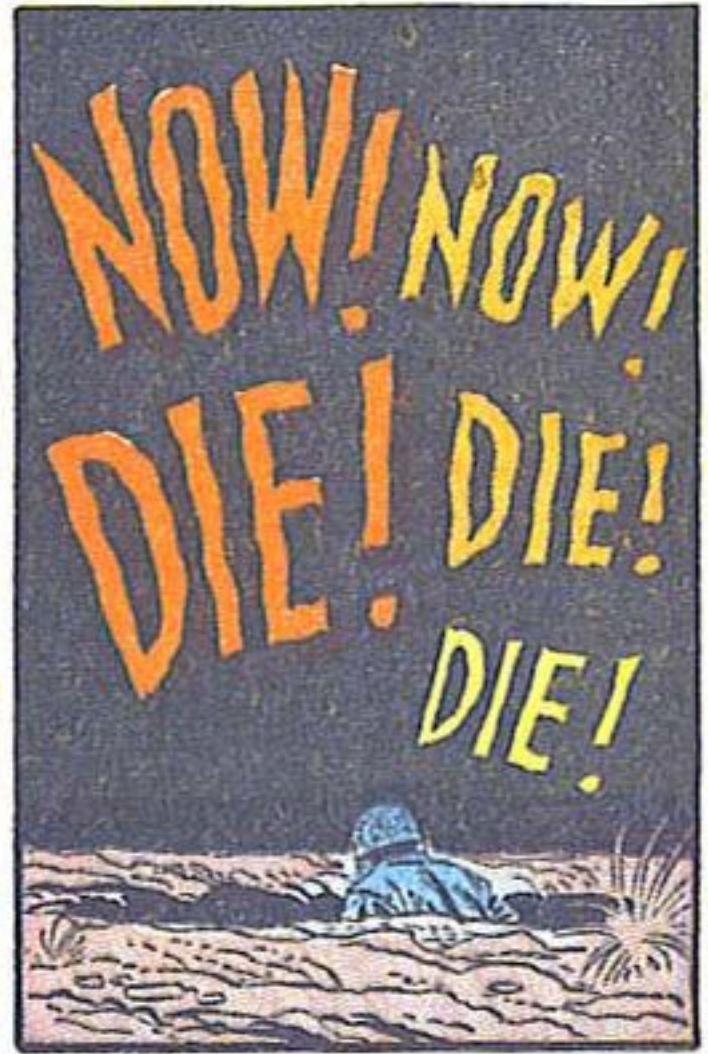
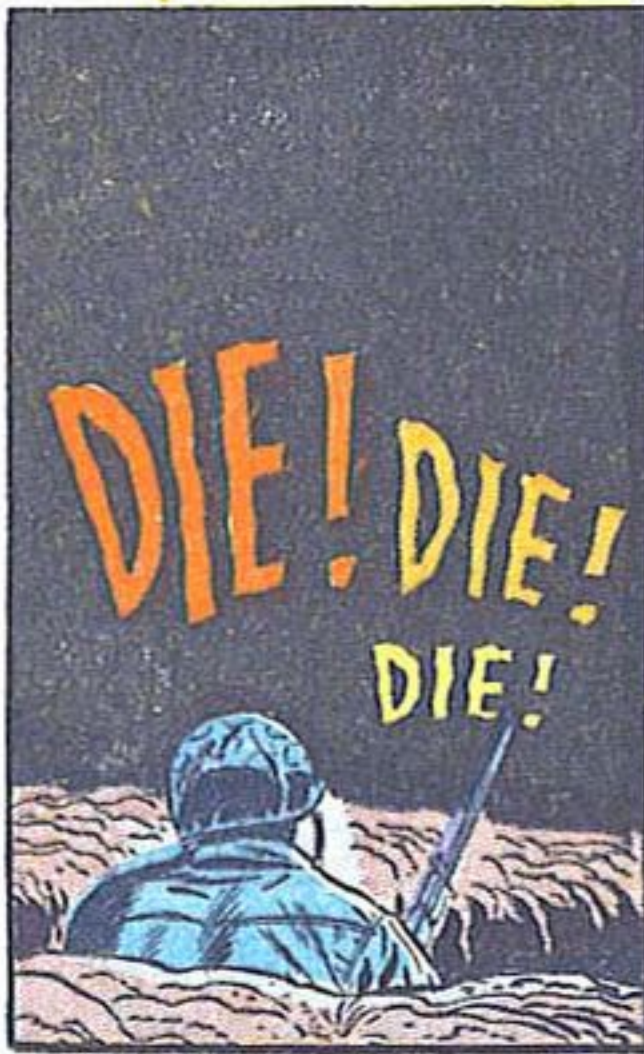




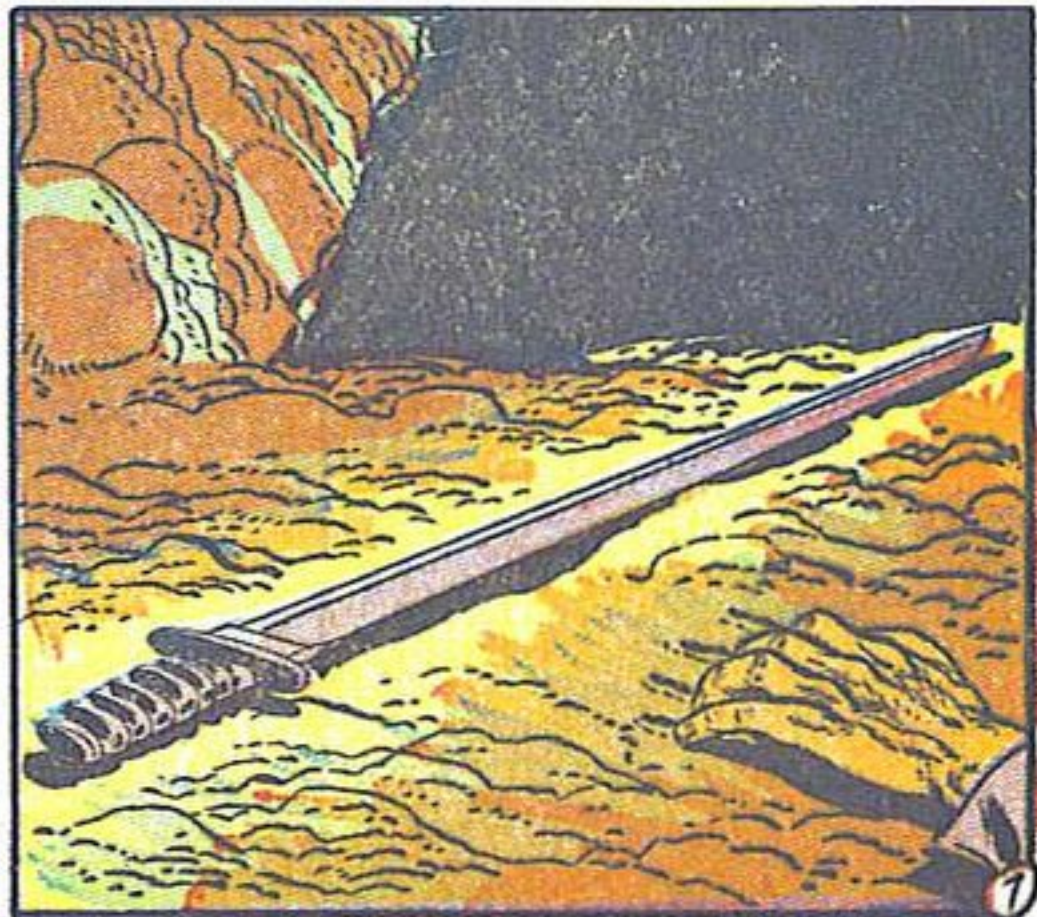
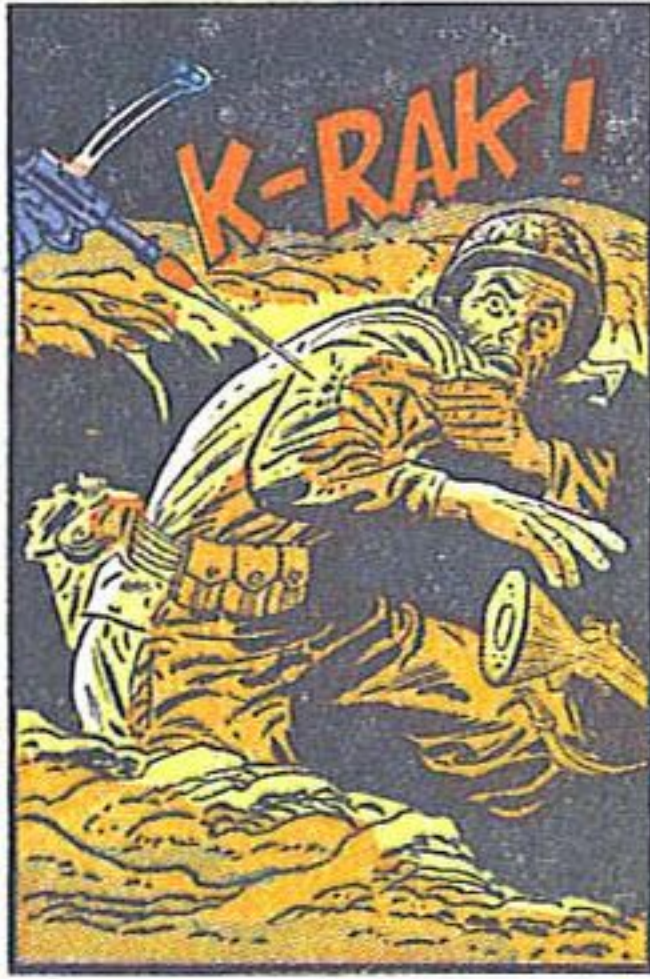




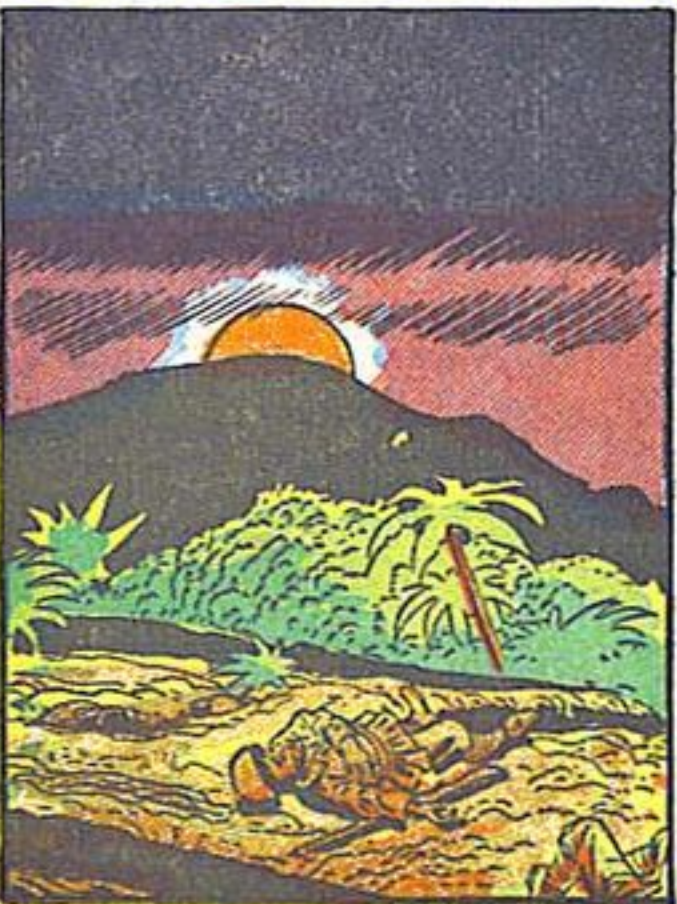
















# Message to Parents



## WHAT TO DO IF POLIO COMES YOUR WAY

Keep children with their own friends. Keep them away from people they have not been with right along, especially in close, daily living. Many people have polio infection without showing signs of sickness. Without knowing it, they can pass the infection on to others.

Try not to get over-tired by work, hard play or travel. If you already have the polio infection in your body, being very tired may bring on serious polio.

Keep from getting chilled. Don't bathe or swim too long in cold water. Take off wet clothes at once. Chilling can lessen your body's protection against polio.

Keep clean. Wash hands carefully before eating and always after using the toilet. Hands may carry polio infection into the body through the mouth. Also keep food clean and covered.

### WATCH FOR EARLY SIGNS OF SICKNESS

Polio starts in different ways—with headache, sore throat, upset stomach or fever. Persons coming down with polio may also feel nervous, cross or dizzy. They may have trouble in swallowing or breathing. Often there is a stiff neck and back.

### ACT QUICKLY—CALL YOUR DOCTOR AT ONCE

Until he comes, keep the patient quiet and in bed, away from others.

Would you like to read more about your old job? Or have you had enough concussion for a change? Everyone knows the worth of the "Long Tom" (155-mm. Rifle). When Mt. Trocchio was blocking the road to Cassino during the Italian Campaign, "Long Toms" were among the 200 guns firing 5000 rounds during a hot 60 minutes which turned the mountain into a roman candle. The barrage lasted until 6:30 A.M., and five and a half hours later, at noon, the hill was taken by the infantry. Oops—they got in again!

Imagine someone from Brooklyn being bashful enough to ask that his name be withheld? And naturally, "G.S." was in the Air Corps. There's no denying the sensational part the Air Corps had in the War. Fighters and bombers did a great job. And had a wonderful coverage. So much so that we wonder whether another correspondent isn't on the right beam when he asks for stories about less glamorous flying jobs—like the "eyes of the artillery." By the "e.o.t.a." of course, he means the Piper Cubs and other midget planes which flew over the front lines to spot concentrations of enemy troops, enemy gun positions, and correct the shell-slinging of their own guns. These "winged Davids'" only protection against the go-liaths of enemy A.A. fire and fighter planes were their maneuverability and slowness. One Cub, jumped by four FW-190's, dove so steeply and leveled out so close to the ground that the fighters feared to follow. Another Cub's slow speed completely baffled an enemy fighter, who couldn't aim his gun sights at him long enough to blast him out of the skies. We promise not to get all tangled up in a mess of military gobble-dedook, Murray. But while we're air-borne, so to speak, here's the dope on the two "e's" you've mentioned. The basic fighter formation from which all other formations are devised is the *element of two*. With the second fighter flying to the side and behind the tail of the first. In this formation, the pilots, while retaining the maneuverability of a single plane, can still protect each other. Doubling this *element of two*, makes it an *echelon of elements*, composed of four planes. Advantage: the pilots can patrol together, and on attack break into two combat teams. In a *stepped-up echelon* the flight's planes are in single file, one behind the other. The maneuver which allows a quick change of formation or direction for whole flights of planes is called the *Peel-Off*. No doubt you've seen the maneuver many times, in which planes *peel-off* to attack enemy formations. Don't be awed by the number of planes in formations. The basic interceptor formation is an element of two planes. One to attack, one to cover the attacker. Two such elements make a flight, and four flights a squadron.
