END OF A CONVOY K-682

Somewhere in the 300-mile blue stretch of ocean which extends from New Guinea to the Japanese stronghold at Rabaul, steamed an enemy convoy carrying 15,000 troops, escorted by 10 warships and screened continuously by Zeros.

Twice the Americans, swarming low in B-17s with P-38 cover went searching for the elusive convoy, but low-hanging clouds gave the enemy perfect cover.

Then, the pilot of a single P-38 spotted the convoy nearing Vitiaz Strait, 100 miles from Lac. The Strait was the only navigable passage through the reefs, and the Americans knew the enemy would have to commit themselves that very night. They would either have to head northwest for Wewak or Medang, splitting their forces in two directions, or make a run through the Strait for Lac.

The Americans had their tactics for each possibility, and weren't fooled when the convoy tried a feint -steaming toward Wewak but, under cover of darkness, turning abruptly and heading for Lae.

All afternoon and night, the Americans busied themselves for the dawn alert. Meanwhile, the movement of the convoy and all other necessary information was being sent in by a P-38 pilot who stuck to the enemy every inch of the way. Typical of his regular 20-minute reports was one that came in like this:

"Enemy convoy now at 05.00 south, 147.30 east, heading 270 degrees, speed eight knots, 25 Zeros circling. Weather fair, ceiling ragged at 5,000 feet, visibility 15 miles plus."

At dawn, the Americans set out with 106 planes B-17's, B-25's, A-20's, P-40's, P-39's, and P-38's. Flying at 10,000 feet, they reached the target on schedule. The enemy convoy stretched out over an area of 15 miles, with a pair of cruisers leading the pack, while destroyers hugged the transports.

The *B-17* squadron leaders were called into the echelon positions, while the *B-25's* and the *A-20's* fell back in preparation for the first run. High overhead, from 15,000 to 23,000 feet, *P-38's* sailed into a pack of *Zeros*. The fight was on.

The warships were streaming ack-ack as the first B-17's started their runs. One B-17, ignoring the blossoming ack-ack bursts all about, unloaded four 1,000-pounders. All but the last, which missed by only 20 leet, went home. The transport seemed to shudder in the water. And while it was still shuddering, the B-25's rolled in on the next wave at masthead height, and finished the job.

Minutes later, a second transport caught a load of 1,000-pounders right in the middle. It opened up like a hinge and went down.

Meanwhile, the Zeros were hitting the bombers from all directions, trying to shake them off their runs. Warnings from fire-control officers crackled from all sides: "Zeros heading in from 11 o'clock! Watch out for this one, boys he's really lining us up!"

And below, the warships were circling frantically, at the same time throwing up streams of flak that bounced the bombers violently.

The Zeros would break through trying to get at the bombers, and whenever they did, the P-39's came screaming down on them with throttles wide open. One P-38 broke a Zero in half with a single burst, then, as it swooped to get out of the way of the flying pieces, came face to face with another Zero, and knocked that one out of the sky.

At the end of 15 minutes, at least two of the transports had vanished completely, while several more were sending up towers of smoke. One of the enemy cruisers had caught one in its gasoline tanks, and bright orange sheets of flame were shooting out of it in all directions.

One Zero, spiraling downward and trailing smoke and flame, crashed on an already smoking cruiser, completing the sinking of the ship.

At the same time, one of the *B-17's* caught a burst of explosive bullets from a *Zero* in its hydraulic fluid line. Flaming oil was sprayed all over the bomb-bay compartment. The pilot was down to 300 feet when the other crewmen beat out the flames with their heavy winter flying suits. Amazingly enough, the plane made it back to its base, 350 miles across the 14,000-foot Owen Stanley Range.

Comedy relief was afforded in the bitterest part of the fighting when one pilot of a B-17 started a run on a cruiser. But before he could complete his run, the cruiser exploded from a direct hit by another plane. The pilot changed his direction and started a run for another cruiser. But this cruiser, too, blew up before he could get close to it. Those who heard the plaintive words of the pilot after this second one will probably never forget them: "Hey, you guys, you trying to hog them all? Save a couple for me!"

But, at the end of 30 short minutes, there were no battleships or transports left for anyone. In half an hour every ship of the convoy was either sunk or burning. For miles around in every direction the sea was littered with 'wreckage. What's more, every last Zero had been knocked down.

This was the Battle of the Bismarck Sea and it was the most savage whipping the Japanese Navy had ever suffered,

Not a single heavy bomber had been lost, although many of them had been hit by as many as 25 Zeros. At times the ack-ack had resembled a curtain of fire, but it had failed to bring down anything but the wrath of the bombers' courageous crews.
