This realm we're living in is an illusion. It's the realm of feelings. This is a dimension that your *flesh and soul* was created from because of the disobedience of Adam.

We all know that atoms are *empty space*. And that's what makes the material dimension that the three dimension operates in. So, things come from spirit to this dimension, which is called *wave to particle* by the direction of God. And He put man in this dimension to be the ruler of the particle dimension connected to the spirit dimension.

But because our senses rule this dimension, we believe that what we *feel, smell, taste and hear* is real.

How we think and how we feel makes up our personality. And from our *personality* we create our *personal reality*. So, that *personal reality* has to validate the image we create. So, all of our thoughts and feelings attract the people into our little bubble that validate how we feel. There's nothing wrong with that as long as you understand it. As long as you know that the reality is a *spirit dimension* and not this dimension.

God loves you. God loves you, and He's not separate from you. You're separate from Him because of your thoughts. So, with this information and instrumentation that we have nowadays, we can remain connected to the spirit realm. As long as we have the mind of Christ.

Right? Yes. Amen.

When our thoughts are not in the spirit realm, we live in this "*cause and effect*" **space time dimension**.

Cause and effect: we're always looking for a reason why something is happening to us.

We say or feel: "Why is this happening to me?"

But the "you" or the "me" that it is happening to **is not** *who you are*. It's the image you've created to have the feelings that you live in.

It's really simple. How many of you know it's really easy? And your body is so objective, it doesn't know if you're having an experience in real time or by thought alone.

You can create high blood pressure with a thought. All you have to do is get your stress hormones involved.

How many of you know what stress is? Have you driven in Mexico lately? If you have, you know what stress is like, right?

So, all of these *emotions* and *feelings* that we have in this physical body cause us to confuse the reality of our spiritual life with this physical dimension.

So, what happens is we read the scriptures and we say, "I want to act like this." So, you try to change yourself from the same *personal reality* and it doesn't work. That's called *matter trying to change matter*. It doesn't work. Only the spirit creates.

So, the longer we stay in the "time space" dimension or the "spirit dimension", the less control this dimension has over your thoughts, because it makes you feel so good. You're not going to let anything from this dimension take you back into the feelings of stress and frustration and all the other things.

So that is the warfare: Staying conscious. That's the warfare.

Because we have these layers of programming over our minds and bodies that make us want to revert back to *reacting*. Whenever we react to a situation in this dimension, we become part of this dimension.

We're not separate from what we see and feel. We think we are because we don't understand the spiritual relationship with everything in this realm.

That's why we lie, cheat, steal, and whatever it takes to get ahead in this dimension. Because we're materialists. All of us have been created as creators, and if we understand that, you know, the life you're living today is nobody else's fault but yours.

It's not your husband's fault, not your mother in law's fault; we create our reality and that's because we live in this separation mentality.

Let me read this scripture. This is a good scripture.

Matthew 22:23-30

The same day the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection, came to Him and asked Him, "Teacher, Moses said that if a man dies, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife and raise up offspring for his brother. Now there were with us seven brothers. The first died after he had married, and having no offspring, left his wife to his brother. Likewise the second also, and the third, even to the seventh. Last of all the woman died also. Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had her."

Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God. For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels of God in heaven."

Now, that verse creates some confusion when you don't understand the Spirit dimension. When Jesus speaks about Heaven, He's talking about Himself. Wherever He was, He was the glory of God in the flesh.

And if you study what the glory of God is, it is resurrection. And there's trillions of angels in the spirit realm all the time.

Matthew 22:31-32

But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying, "I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?" God is not the God of the dead, but of the living. So, when you talk about God, you talk about the spiritual dimension, which has no relationship with this dimension when it comes to living, dying and senses.

The **separation** we make between *"Heaven"* and *"this dimension"* is all a fairy tale in your minds. There is no separation. There is no separation.

We create the separation to edify and validate our image and senses.

There's nothing wrong with that. You want to live in your physical vessel and experience things, there is nothing wrong with that. Be aware of what you're doing.

If you're conscious of that, you won't look at your neighbor with disdain, or you won't have enemies, or you won't be fighting everything because you'll understand it from a different perspective.

Many people have this idea. "Well, when I get this resurrected body like Jesus, I'll have this, and I'll have that because of what happened at His resurrection."

And many of you already have your wallpaper picked out for your mansion in Heaven.

You are "the mansion", and you're in Heaven now. You're living in eternity now.

You say: "But yeah, my back hurts and I've got these bills, and my mother in law doesn't like me..." That's the drama we've created to experience the image that we live in. In the same chapter, Matthew 22:34-39

But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the law?"

And Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment, and the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Jesus was showing mankind on the planet what separates him from seeing the Spirit dimension. If you use the frequency of love, you can change your heart, your mind, and your soul.

All the "division" that we have in our mind and in our heart comes from those parts of our being. Whatever *you think* sends a signal out into space and *your heart* is this magnetic force that draws those thoughts back.

See, you're this *electromagnetic being* that's capable of attracting what you think about.

So, if you're thinking that your neighbor is your enemy then you're going to be living beside a neighbor that is chopping down your trees and pulling over your fences. He will be your enemy and your emotional state, because of your heart and your soul, will be looking for enemies or whatever it is that you feel like is against you.

But when you love the Lord your God, Someone you *can't see*, Someone that is *not visible* to your senses, Someone you *can't touch*...when you have that kind of love that's able to reach into that dimension, all of a sudden your heart starts to attract all of those things that you can't see into your life. And guess what happens? You start seeing everybody else as yourself.

When you start loving God, you start loving you. That's where most of the problems start. There's nothing wrong with you. God loves you. He just wants you to tap into the love He has for you. Nobody is going to be perfect like Jesus. That always struck me as very humorous. When people go to church, they think *all of a sudden,* they have to be holy.

Sin is not what you do, it's what you believe. What you do is the byproduct of what you believe.

When you start understanding that Love that's so beyond this material realm, you'll be less of a materialist and more of a spiritualist.

The reason you're a materialist is because you're looking at this dimension to protect yourself. You don't want any circumstances to create problems for your physical body, so you start focusing all of your energy and attention on the material realm.

Then Jesus says, "Start practicing loving your Heavenly Father with all of your senses, and organs (body), and watch what happens to the circumstances around you."

And the reason Jesus said that is because He's telling you, "Get your attention off this dimension and start seeing who you really are in a dimension you can't put your senses in."

But it really takes conscious effort. Before you get out of bed every morning, practice what you want to be that day. *"What's the greatest expression I can be of myself today?"*

Not "How I can act holier than anyone else," but rather, "What's the greatest expression of me?"

And when you get that image inside of you and you start practicing that through a conscious effort and your attention, things will start to change.

Do you want to meet the Divine today? Be divine yourself.

John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

You probably ought to write that down.

Peace is not an *emotion*. Peace is a *state of being*.

Even Jesus was talking about tribulation back in His time. There's nothing happening on the planet today that hasn't already happened or been happening since beginning of time. Tribulation is tribulation. So, when Jesus said, *"Have peace,"* He's talking about *wholeness* because you have to be, "in Him". Say, "In Him." So, if we are "in Him", we have peace.

Ephesians 1:3-4

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. Just as He chose us in Him (say, "in Him") before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

Separation is not understanding that verse. Wholeness is understanding that verse. If you're here today, you were in Him before the foundation of the world. Therefore, who told you that you left?

Say, "I did." You did. You told yourself you left. You decided you wanted to play in the *material realm*. You decided you wanted to "feel something". It's okay. You wanted to experience something, it's okay. *"You hurt my feelings."*

As long as you understand *what dimension* you're operating in, you can do whatever you want. But you have to understand what *"before the foundation of the world"* means.

The words "World" and "Earth" are not the same word. You "create" your world. You "create your world" through your *personality* and *personal reality*. So, don't go crying to God when things aren't working out in *your world*. Understanding "*before the foundation of the world*," is really critical in the scripture. And I'm not going to preach on it today, but there's probably a book out there about it ③.

It's called, "Before the Foundation of the World" by Emerson Ferrell.

But as long as you understand that, then you will understand what makes up "the foundation of the world". It is the "fear" of "death", because we believe this physical body is who we are.

So, way back in Genesis, when Adam disobeyed, he was *afraid* and that's why he hid from God. And his words were so powerful that whatever he spoke came into being. He named all the animals. So, when he told God, "I'm afraid" that "fear" was in the planet, in the earth.

Hence, when you grow up in this planet, or when you're born into this planet, you get that *mind of Adam*. So that's why you have to understand that *"before the foundation of the world",* you were in a place where fear did not exist, and you were in a place where you could have whatever you wanted. And that's why you're here today. And when you wake up one day you're going to remember all of this.

And that day is coming sooner than you think.
