Clarifications:

Page 35 – Answer to On Your Own 1.9 – Update the entire answer to the following:

Science is not about proving things but is about collecting evidence and making conclusions based on that evidence. If scientists discover evidence that contradicts a current hypothesis, theory, or law, then that hypothesis, theory, or law must be changed or discarded.

Corrections:

Page 9 – 2nd paragraph under Testing Hypotheses – in the first sentence, change ‘disproved’ to ‘did not support’ so it reads:

“If you said it **did not support** the hypothesis,…”

Pages 83-84 – Revise the last sentence on page 83 that carries over to page 84 as follows:

Many important Greek texts were rediscovered during the **11th century in Spain** and began to be translated.
