Lazarus and the Rich Man: Luke 16

Where will you spend eternity?

This is a question we each need to think about. The Bible has the answers to that question. Listen close so that you can decide for yourself where you will spend eternity.

If Someone asked you to live in the most wonderful place in the entire Universe, would you want to live there? Yes!

The Bible tells us that God lives in the most wonderful place called Heaven. It is a beautiful place where there is no suffering, no sickness and no pain. In Heaven there are beautiful mansions, streets of gold, and the sweet song of angels singing praises to God. And the best thing about Heaven is this, Jesus is there! Jesus is God's only Son and He loves you more than you can even know! And Jesus wants you to live in Heaven with Him. But there is a problem that keeps us from Heaven. That problem is sin. God is perfect and holy and never sins. He cannot allow sin into Heaven. Each one of us is born into this world as a sinner. That means we think, say and do things that are against God. The Bible says that our sin separates us from God and keeps us from Heaven. As a matter of fact our sins are so




This is the rich man. He had everything! Every day he dressed in fancy clothes. He ate the best food in his fancy house. Everyone loved to be with the rich man!
