DURING World War II, a fleet of the U. S. Navy idled far off the coast of a Pacific island, while the fighting men aboard impatiently paced the decks. Meanwhile, from an American base hundreds of miles away, Army bombers were taking off on schedule to plaster the enemy island on what was supposed to be a combined, synchronized attack by the fleet unit and the planes.

Now, the fleet unit was in grave danger of upsetting the timetable. The hitch? An enemy minefield between the fleet unit and the island. Given time, the old, tried and true methods of locating and destroying enemy mines would have worked. But there wasn't time. The enemy had seen to that by planting 10 times the usual number.

It was at this critical moment that the U.S.S. Tunny (SS 282) arrived with its new FM sonar equipment. And, while seasoned Navy commanders followed the action with astonishment, the Tunny confidently penetrated the enemy minefield and brought back the exact locations of 220 mines.

The successful action that followed was dramatic proof that warfare had entered a new phase—the era of electronics. Variations of this incident were duplicated in many different fields of naval activity be-

fore the war's end, and one top Navy commander recently said:

"One thing is certain. The war could not have been won without the aid of electronic equipments and systems."

"Electronics" is one of the least understood words in use today. If you don't think so, ask the first friend you meet and ask him to give you a workable definition of the word.

In the broadest sense electronics includes all electric phenomena. The dictionary calls it "that branch of science and technology which relates to the conduction of electricity through gases or in vacuo."

A simpler definition might be, "The science of freeing electrons from the atom, and of harnessing and applying them to such uses as radar, sonar, radio, and television."

The appearance of the U.S.S. Tunny on that fateful day came as a complete surprise to most Navy men at the time. That's because all the work of the Navy Electronics Laboratory (NEL) was, and still is, classified.

Not only the general public, but even a large segment of the Navy, rarely hears about its accomplishments. Just the same, the products of its laboratory made, and are still making, a tremendous difference

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in battle tactics and in those long-range developments which alter grand strategy.

The fact that NEL goes all the way back to 1906 when the Navy established a tiny radio station atop Pt. Loma, Calif., is indicative of the Navy's far-sighted planning. On January 1, 1940, the Navy Radio and Sound Laboratory was set up on the point. Finally, in June of 1941 the Bureau of Ships directed the Laboratory to provide space and facilities for the University of California Division of War Research. Electronics for war was under way.

During World War II, and throughout the Korean fighting, NEL played a vital part in keeping the Navy supplied with the latest and best equipment in the field of electronics. Think of what our Navy would be today without such gear as radar, sonar and fire control installations!

But this is only a small part of electronics' contributions. All the delicate mechanisms that are essential to most of the electrical equipment used in the ship or naval aircraft, guided missiles, guns, communications, etc., are electronically controlled.

NEL is still operating on a 24-hour basis, and all of its activities are devoted to one objective—making electronics useful to the fleet.

The Laboratory atop Pt. Loma, which is in sight of San Diego, has mushroomed since its inception. Most of its larger buildings rest on outer Pt. Loma, only a few hundred yards above warships which pass in and out of San Diego harbor.

Since 1945 new but allied activities have been made part of the Laboratory The Oceanographic research laboratories are now part of NEL, working hand in hand with NEL.

But NEL hasn't put all its eggs in one basket. Pt. Loma is only one of several

spots where NEL specialists work. On lonely desert stations in Arizona and on San Clemente Island, Calif., experiments are taking place day and night. Other experiments are conducted in laboratories located in the remote forests of Lake Pend Oreille, Idaho.

Still other NEL scientists, in their never ceasing quest of knowledge relating to electronics, have penetrated the Arctic and Antarctic oceans, and have played important roles in the atomic and hydrogen bomb developments.

Out of NEL's never-ending program of research and development have emerged concrete solutions of tricky problems that have long badgered scientists working on other war weapons.

NEL, for example, helped to devise the electronic controls and systems needed to make the guided missile efficient at long distances. And the 22,000,000 electron-volt betatron at the Laboratory has enabled NEL researchers to study photographs made through 24-inch-thick steel.

Thanks to NEL, electronics has come into its own. At sea it is now used to detect and locate enemies and to communicate within a ship and between ships, planes and shore stations.

NEL trained technicians also use electronic equipment to gather and analyze information at lightning speeds. A commander-in-chief can now, by means of complicated "nerve and motor" networks, coordinate large numbers of vessels and planes moving at high speeds over vast areas.

Because of this, electronics has been able to change the whole aspect of sea warfare. Previously, battles were fought within relatively limited areas. Today, task force commanders can put electronics to work for them and wage their battles over an area of hundreds and thousands of miles.
