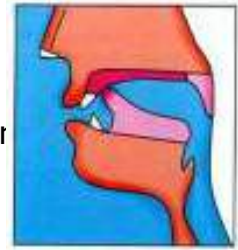
Phonetics

Pronunciation: It's similar to the American English pronunciation of (r) between vowels: waiter

Exit: The tip of the tongue and it's back with the gums of the two upper central incisors.

Raa' with Fat-hah or Dammah is a heavy letter.

Raa' with Kasrah is a light letter.
