## **ORIGAMI ROCKETS**


Materials Needed: 1 Square of origami paper 2 Squares of tissue paper Tip: If your paper is curled up really tightly, place it under a book and let it flatten before you get started.





Fold your paper in half so that you have a line going through the middle of the X Fold opposite corners together so that you

have an X fold through your paper



Tip: As you make each fold, be sure to crease your folds extra flat!



Fold both sides of your square into the center crease so that your paper is now shaped like a rectangle. Then fold the bottom of your rectangle to the middle.











Turn your paper upside down. Fold bottom part into two triangles that touch the middle crease. Fold the back flap down.







Turn your paper over and upside down. Fold the top corners to the center line so that they form a triangle.





Fold one edge of your rocket to the middle line. Then fold the triangle down. Repeat this on the other side











Turn your rocket over and there it is! Use the tissue paper to make flames for your ship!







Bonus: If you don't feel like adding flames to your rocket, challenge yourself and see if you can make a tiny rocket out of the tissue paper!
