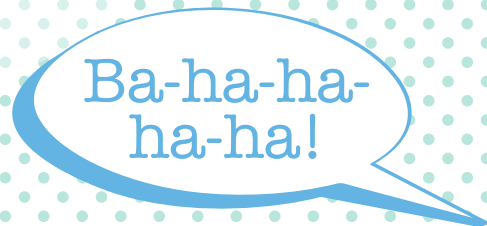

Q: What do you give a lemon in distress?

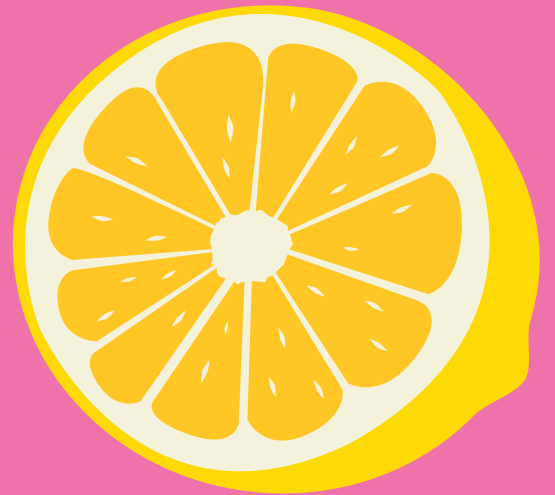
A: Lemonade.

A:

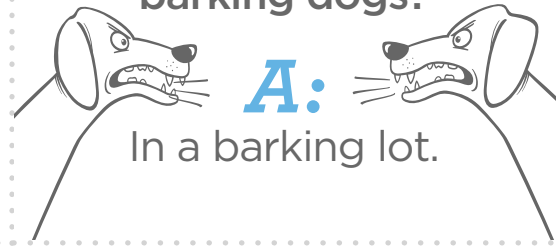
A gummy bear!

A:

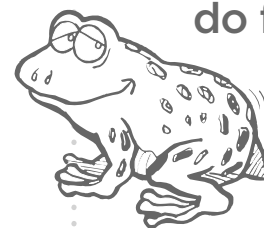
Fry-days!

A:

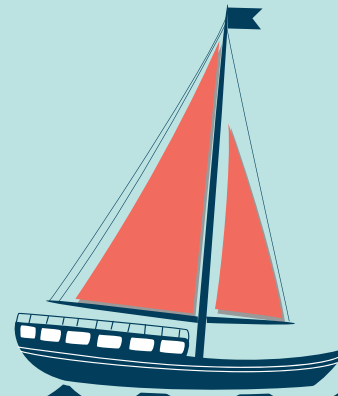
The same thing Arkansas.

Q:

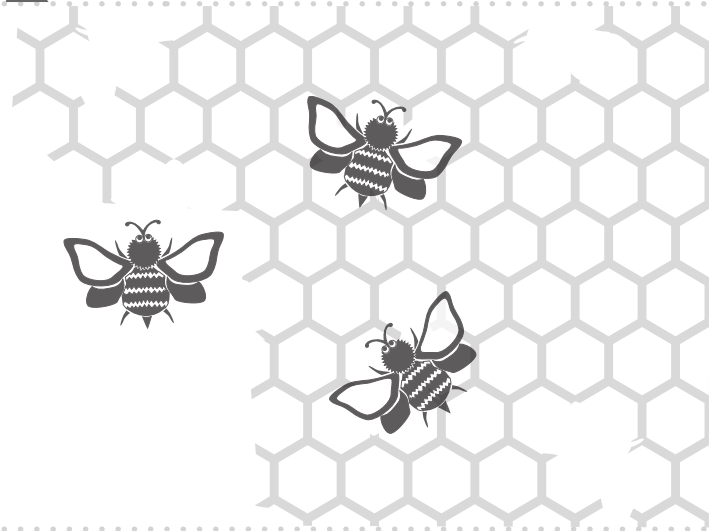
What do you call an alligator wearing a vest?

A: Because they have honeycombs.

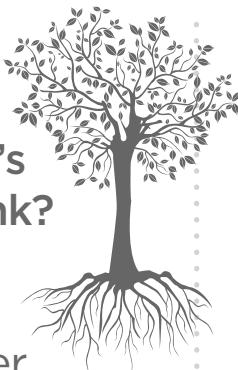


Q:

A:

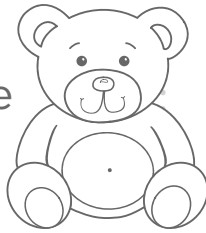
Nice belt!

French flies and a Diet Croak.

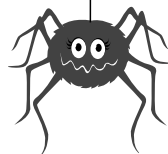


Q:

What kind of music do mummies like?

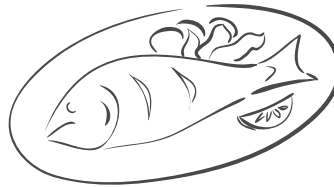
A:

A:

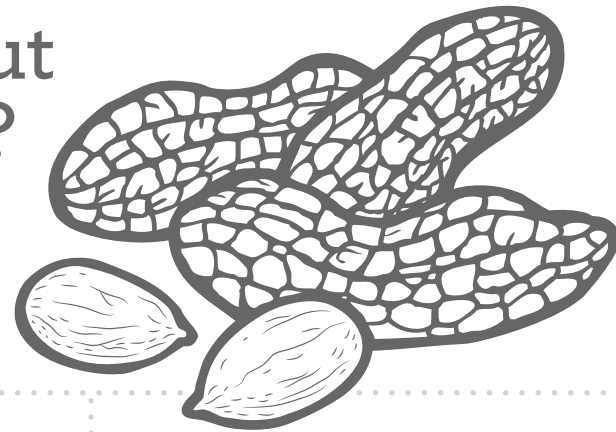
With sheets of ice and blankets of snow.

A:

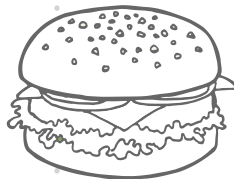
Fish and ships.

To see how long he slept.

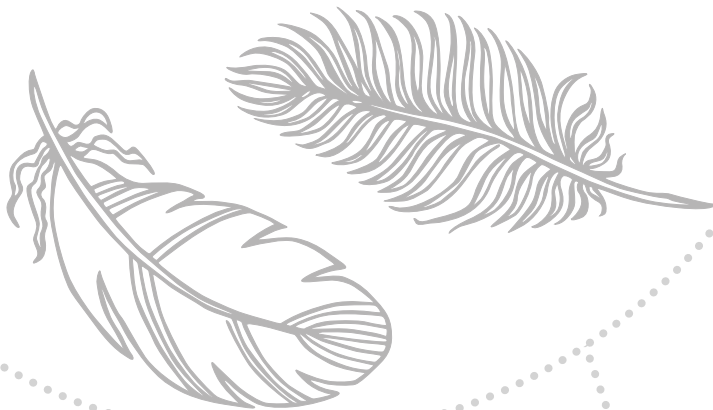
Q: What do ghosts use to wash their hair?

Q:

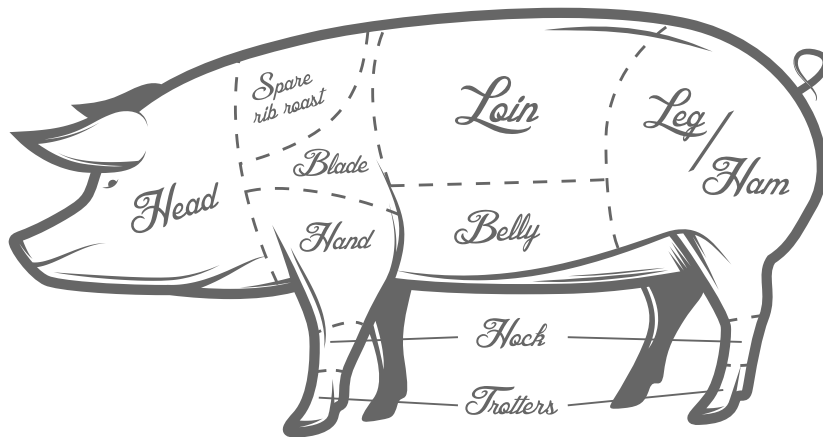
What happens when a red ship crashes into a blue ship?
