▶ <u>Superlativo de Superioridade</u>: de adjetivos ou de advérbios com mais de uma sílaba é formado com the most.

Sylvia is **the most popular** girl I know. ( a mais ... )

Leap Year seems to be **the most romantic** film we've ever watched. ( o mais ... )

▶ <u>O Superlativo de Superioridade</u>: de adjetivos e advérbios com uma só sílaba é formado com a terminação est. Observe:
