



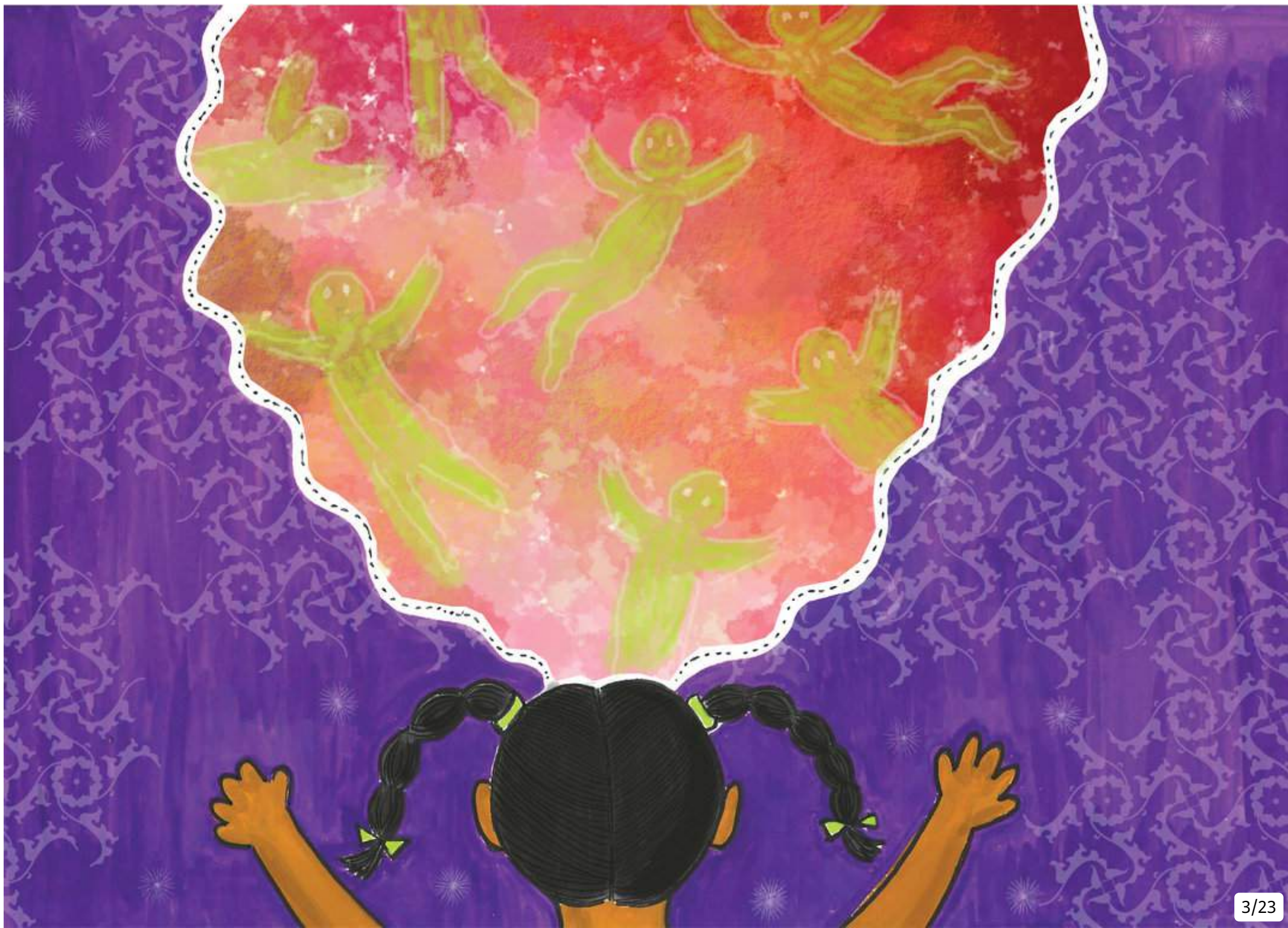

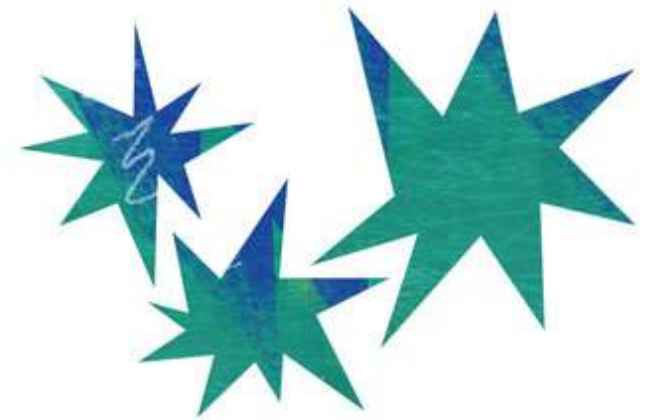

do they thump-thump when they walk?

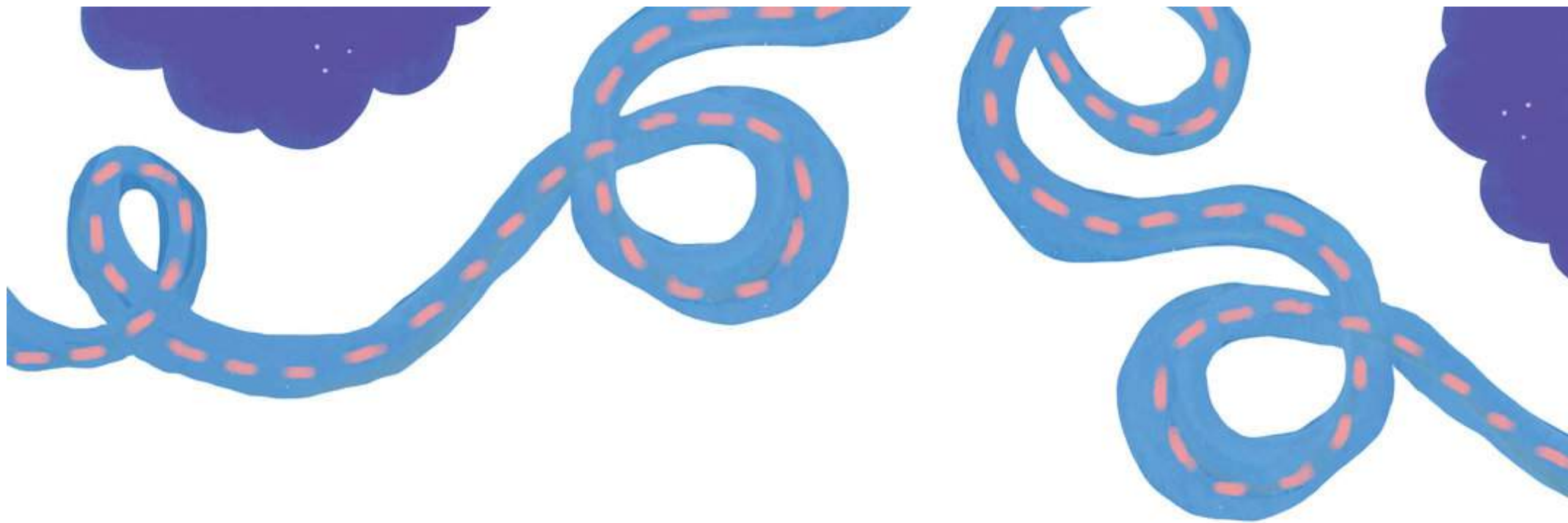




Do they spin and spin and spin  
with the fan and get di-diz-dizzy?

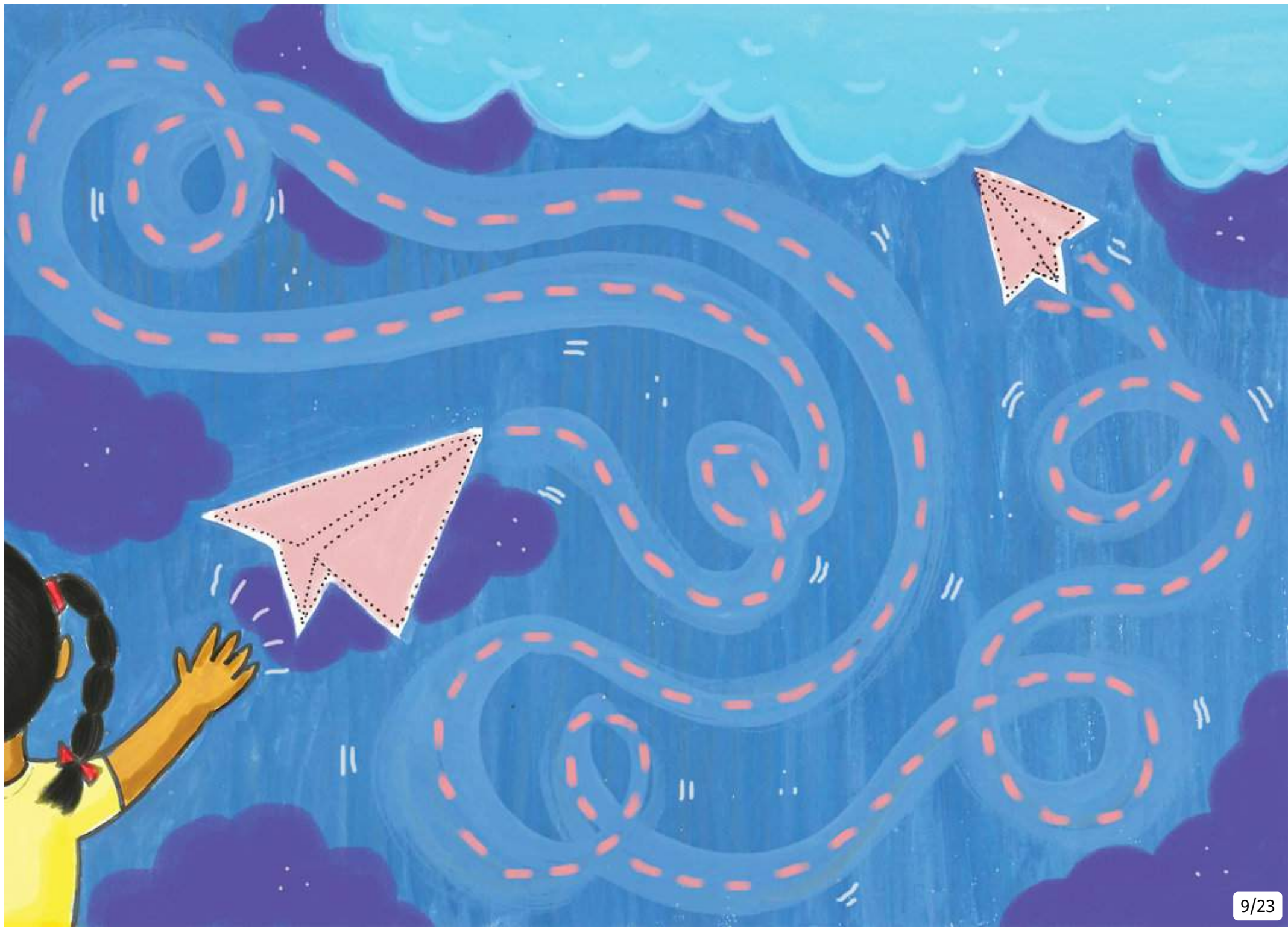






Do they ride on a paper plane

looking for a treat?



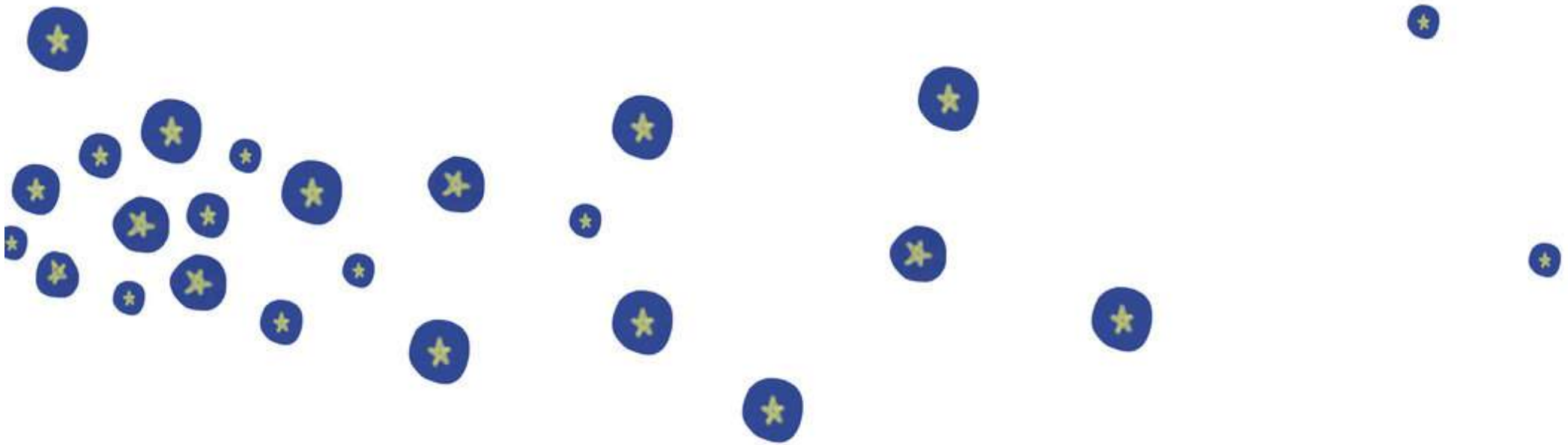




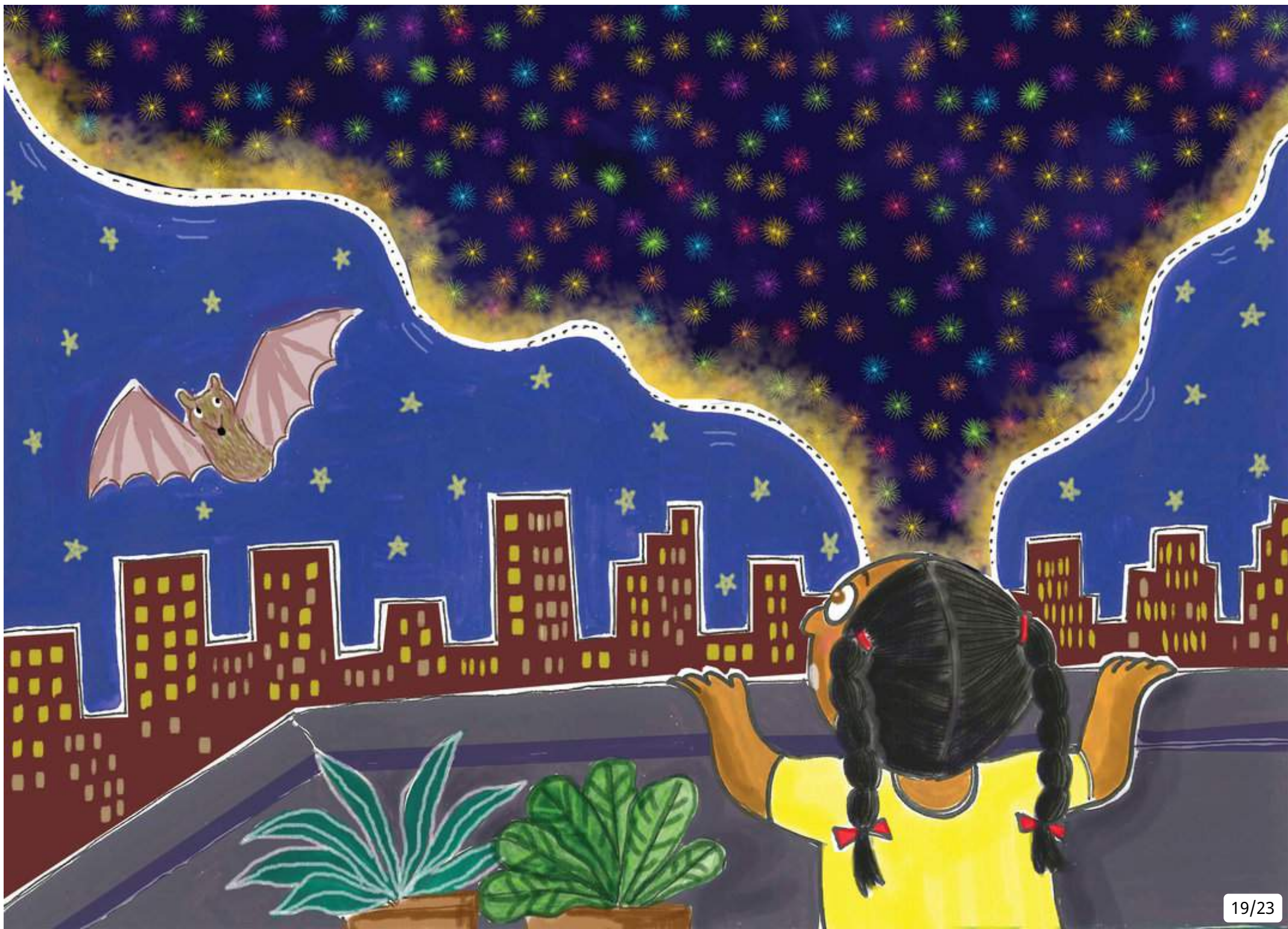
Do they grow up to be tomatoes
