
## GOD CALLS HIS PEOPLE TO WORSHIP


# Reading of the Word—from Exodus 20:1-17

## GOD CALLS HIS PEOPLE TO CONFESSION, REPENTANCE, AND RECONCILIATION

The people of God respond to His Word by confessing their sins, repenting of their sinful ways, and seeking God's favor through the reconciling work of Jesus, the Son of God.

#### Confession of Sin—based on Isaiah 55:8; Exodus 20:1-17

Pastor: Lord, we come confessing. We acknowledge that our thoughts are not Your thoughts, neither are our ways Your ways. You spoke all these words, saying, "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

All: "You shall have no other gods before Me. You shall not make for yourself a carved image. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy."

Pastor: Your law pierces our heart. Lord, have mercy.

All: "Honor your father and your mother. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal."


#### Assurance of Pardon—Isaiah 1:16-18; Mark 12:30

People: We lift them up to the Lord.


Pastor: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

angels, the archangels, and the whole company of Heaven in this hymn of eternal praise:



#### WORDS OF INSTITUTION AND THE LORD'S TABLE


This table is open to all baptized Christians who have made a profession of faith. You may come forward to receive the bread and wine or grape juice.

Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, on Earth as it is in Heaven.


Give us this day our daily bread.

#### Worship Notes:

Betty Scott Stam served as a missionary to China in the 1930s and was killed by communists for her belief in the Gospel. As a high-schooler, she wrote this prayer: "Lord, I give up my own plans and purposes, all my own desires, hopes and ambitions... Work out Thy whole will in my life at any cost, for to me to live is Christ. Amen." Betty recognized the true benefit of obedience to the tenth commandment. She believed that life in Christ is the only place of rest and happiness. As we hear the Word preached from the tenth commandment, may we believe that "to live is Christ, to be His servant." May our prayers echo Betty's, asking the Lord to give us hearts that love His will, free from discontent and envy, and knowing and desiring His precepts. Rather than grumbling about the things we don't have, may we praise the Lord who shelters us under His wings and fulfills our desires in what He ordains. He hears our brokenhearted cries and leads us to the rock to rest. May the Lord dissolve our coveting hearts in thankfulness and reorient our desires to give Christ the glory in life or death. —Emma Marsh
