
## GOD CALLS HIS PEOPLE TO WORSHIP

# Scripture Reading—Isaiah 11:1-5

There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from his roots shall bear fruit. And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. And His delight shall be in the fear of the Lord. He shall not judge by what his eyes see, or decide disputes by what His ears hear, but with righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips He shall kill the wicked. # Reading of the Word—1 John 3:23-4:6


And this is His commandment, that we believe in the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as He has commanded us. <sup>24</sup> Whoever keeps His commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

<sup>4:1</sup> Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world. <sup>2</sup> By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, <sup>3</sup> and every spirit that does not confess Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you heard was coming and now is in the world already. <sup>4</sup> Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you is greater than He who is in the world. <sup>5</sup> They are from the world; therefore they speak from the world, and the world listens to them. <sup>6</sup> We are from God. Whoever knows God listens to us; whoever is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the Spirit of truth and the spirit of error.

# GOD CALLS HIS PEOPLE TO CONFESSION, REPENTANCE, AND RECONCILIATION

The people of God respond to His Word by confessing their sins, repenting of their sinful ways, and seeking God's favor through the reconciling work of Jesus, the Son of God.

## Confession of Sin—from Jeremiah 5:31; 6:10, 14

Pastor: Lord, we come confessing. You have said, "To whom shall I speak and give warning, that

they may hear? Behold, their ears are uncircumcised, they cannot listen."

All: Behold, Your word, O Lord, has been to us an object of scorn; we have taken no pleasure in it.

Pastor: We have healed the wound of Your people lightly, saying, "Peace, peace," when there is no peace.

All: The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests rule at their direction; we love to have it so.

Pastor: What will we do when the end comes?

## Assurance of Pardon—Romans 10:9-10; John 3:16-17

If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

Pastor: This is the promise of God. This is the Word of the Lord.

All: For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Pastor: For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him.

All: Thanks be to God.

People: We lift them up to the Lord.


Pastor: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.


#### GOD SENDS HIS PEOPLE OUT

By this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us. —1 John 3:24

Today, along with the rest of the Western church, we remember the events of the day of Pentecost. Known as Whitsunday in the English-speaking world, this celebration focuses on the giving of the Holy Spirit to the church. Red is used on the bulletin cover and in the decorations in the sanctuary to remind us of the tongues of flame which fell upon the disciples in the upper room. Hymns such as Come, O Creator Spirit Blest, Come Down O Love Divine, Spirit Of The Living God, Lord, Keep Us Steadfast In Thy Word, Breathe On Me Breath Of God, and There Is A Redeemer celebrate the "Comforter of priceless worth," who promises to "fall fresh on [us]," visits us with "ardor glowing," "fills us with life anew," and remains with us until our work on earth is done. Fittingly, on this day when we remember the gift of God's Spirit, we come to a passage in 1 John that reminds us that we are only able to keep the commandments, to love one another, and to overcome the world through the gift of the Holy Spirit. As we worship this morning, let's give thanks for the Spirit who is always at work within us, fanning the flames of love. —Henry C. Haffner
