

City of Mayetta
Minutes
January 4, 2012

The Mayetta City Council met in regular session on Wednesday, January 4th, 2012 at 7:30 PM in City Hall.

Mayor Wimer called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Present were Mayor Jonathan Wimer, Councilmembers, Karla Eigenman, Judy Penfield, Rudy Schmidt and Shelley Ramage. Absent was Dan Whiteman.

Whiteman arrived at 7:35 PM.

Consent Agenda: Eigenman motioned to approve the consent agenda including the minutes of December 7, 28, and the monthly payment voucher. Penfield seconded the motion. Vote five yes zero no.

Ernie DeBusk: Has talked to Terry Alexander of Alexander Pumps to see if it would be possible to put a booster pump on the outlet side of the water tower so we could maintain at least 40 lbs. of pressure no matter what the water level is in the water tower. There have been several complaints about the water pressure from all parts of town and a booster pump could help resolve that problem. Council ask DeBusk to do further research, check with Kansas Rural Water Association to see if any other city has done something like this and to get cost estimates for everything it would take to get it installed and bring it back to the next meeting..

Mayor Wimer said he would talk to Kansas Rural Water to see if they would send someone to the next meeting to discuss the water pressure. Wimer is also going to ask DeBusk to raise the lower end of the water level in the water tower to see if it makes a difference in the pressure.

Completion of Work Certificate: Whiteman motioned to approve the completion of work certificate for Herrman's Excavating. Penfield seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.

Ordinance No. 70-1-12: Schmidt motioned to approve Ordinance no. 70-1-12 and ordinance repealing ordinance no 70-1-93. Ramage seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.

Bob Gay: ask the council if a cereal malt license would allow him to serve 5% beer. Cereal malt license is just for 3.2 beer. Gay would have to get a license from the state to serve alcohol if he wants to serve 5% beer.

Clerks Report: Larry Larkin signed consent to annex and filled out an application for water service.

Financial Reports: Council reviewed the monthly, quarterly, and annual financial reports.

Whiteman reported that the fire hydrant across from the school is not working. He also said that the fire department wanted permission to dispose of the Christmas decorations when they take them down as they are in bad shape and cannot be repaired.

Adjourn: Schmidt motioned to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 PM. Ramage seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.
