Minutes
June 6, 2012

The Mayetta City Council met in regular session on Wednesday June 6, 2012 at 7:30 PM in City Hall.

Call to Order: Mayor Wimer called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.

Roll Call: Present were Mayor Jonathan Wimer, Councilmembers, Rudy Schmidt, Judy Penfield, Dan Whiteman, Shelley Ramage and Karla Eigenman.

Ken Burger, Wayne Manufacturing: Ken brought several samples of Christmas decorations for the council to choose from. There is a 4-year warranty on the decorations and Burger will give us the May sale price if we purchase the decorations before the end of June.

Bud Stauffer represented the fire department said he preferred the diamond shaped decorations.

Deb Hunter: attended the meeting to bring up a concern she has with the picnic tables at the park. They have graffiti on them that is not appropriate for small children; the trash barrels have the bottoms out of them and need replaced, and the concrete in the shelter house has chalk drawings on it.

Hunter also said there was broken glass on 3rd street by the Methodist Church in the alley. Hunter volunteered to clean up the glass.

Council discussed the need to organize a cleanup day at the park. Schmidt volunteered to check on the park to see what needs done with the picnic tables.

After some discussion, the council decided to purchase 10 Christmas decorations. Whiteman will check to see if we have enough poles with working electricity for 10 decorations.

The July regular meeting falls on the 4th holiday it was decided to hold the meeting on July 2nd at 7:30 PM.

July 23 at 5:00 PM was set for a budget workshop.

The August regular meeting will be moved to August 8th beginning with a hearing at 6:00, and 6:30 for unsafe structures and a hearing for the budget at 7:15 PM with the regular meeting to start at 7:30 PM.

Whiteman motioned to approve resolution 02-2012 Schmidt seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.

Whiteman motioned to approved resolution 01-2012. Penfield seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.

The trailer at 214 Clark Street has been removed and cleaned up.

Council reviewed the monthly financial reports.

Eigenman motioned to approve the consent agenda including the minutes of May 2nd and the monthly payment voucher. Ramage seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.

Clerks Report: The Sewer project on 4th street is ready to start next week. Received an estimate from the county to chip and seal 1 mile of street is \$15,000. We have approximately 1.5 miles of street to do. The council decided to remove 3rd Street, James Street, and Jones West of Main in that order if needed. The work is planned for July 9th.

Council Reports: Schmidt received a complaint about a rooster crowing and waking up people in the neighborhood at 2nd and Clark St.

Schmidt ask about revisiting the raises for employees. No action was taken.

Mayors Report: Had a request from the business association to ask KDOT for a sign at 158th Road indicating Mayetta Business District.

Penfield motioned to adjourn the meeting at 10:45 PM. Ramage seconded the motion. Vote 5 yes 0 no.
