

2014 ST. SIMONS TO SAVANNAH RACE NOTICE OF RACE

This is an overnight offshore sailing race from St. Simons Island, GA to Savannah, GA. The race is hosted by the Golden Isles Sailing Club.

1 RULES

1.1 The race shall be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016*, except as modified by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. From sunrise to sunset, the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea will be in effect. The Golden Isles Sailing Club is the Organizing Authority for this race.

1.2 Rule 42 is changed so that engines may be used for propulsion with the incurrance of a motoring penalty as described in the Sailing Instructions.

1.3 Rule 52 is changed so that the race may be sailed with the assistance of self-steering gear, electric or wind.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The race is open to monohull and multihull yachts that comply with all ISAF Category 3 requirements.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to the address below.
