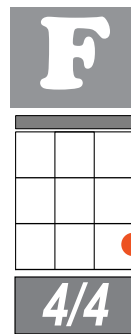


# Fields of Gold (Gordon Sumner)

 In his arms she fell as her hair came down, Among the fields of gold.

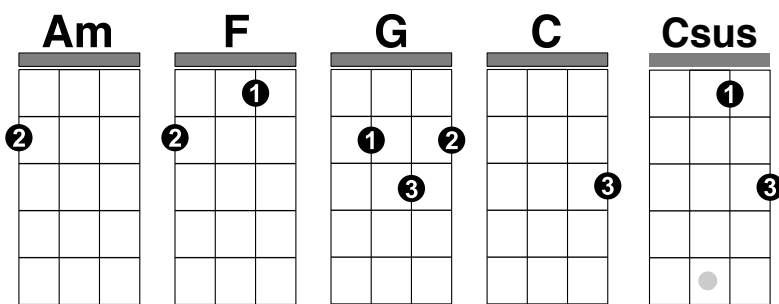
*Am* / *F* / *F* *G* *C* /
