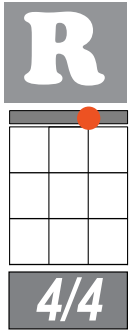


## Raindrops Keep Fallin' On My Head

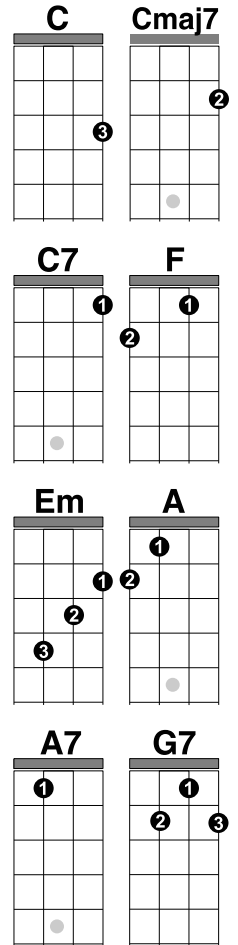


**1** *C* *C<sup>maj7</sup>*
