5. Peter Milne James Scott Skinner called Peter Milne his mentor and "one of the finest native musicians that Scotland ever produced." Milne (1824-1908) composed around thirty tunes which contain excitement and beauty. Best known tunes include *John McNeill's Reel*, *Gillan's Reel* and *The Shakins o' the Pocky*.
