Angus Fitchet Angus Fitchet (1910-1992) was born in Dundee and learned the fiddle from his father at an early age - at 12 he was playing in the local cinema along with the silent movies of the era. After the second world war he joined the Jimmy Shand Band and toured with them for years before forming his own band, and then played with Jimmy Blue's band. His most popular compositions include *John Stephen of Chance Inn*, *Elizabeth Adair*, *J B Milne*, *Lament for Will Starr* and *Mr Michie*.
