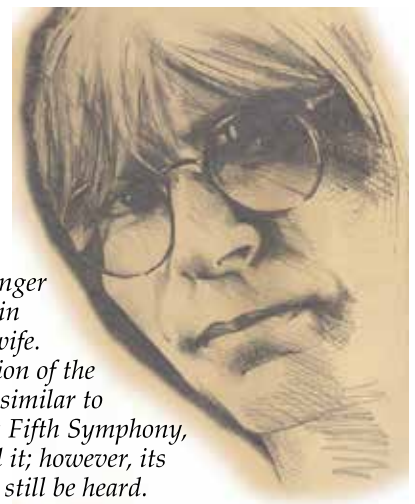


Annie's Song (John Denver)
