



04: Ray's Classic (Willie Hunter)

Chord progression for the first staff: A, D, A, Bm, Bm

Chord progression for the second staff: A, D, A, Bm, E, A

Chord progression for the third staff: A, D, Bm, E

Chord progression for the fourth staff: C#, F#m, A, E, A

This is played in Ireland as "The Race Classic", and some assume it's a polka from the south of Ireland. However, it was composed by the Shetland fiddler Willie Hunter, and called "Ray's Classic" to commemorate a car. I have also heard it called "Roy's Session".
