Key Stage One to Key Stage Two Transition Matrices:

The data demonstrates progression between key stages and, in particular, can help drill down on progress based on prior attainment. Cells are coloured **blue to indicate unsatisfactory progress**, **green for expected progress (two levels)** and **purple for better than expected progress (three levels or more)**.
