We have allocated the Pupil Premium Grant funding (£141,000) to the following areas:

Improving attainment, accelerating progress and reducing the gap between pupil premium students and non-pupil premium students both nationally and with similar schools

- Contribution to the salary costs of: a Safeguarding Lead Coordinator and two Family Support Workers all of whom will provide pastoral support, parenting programmes, attendance monitoring and intervention and rapid response support for children and families.
- Contribution to the salary costs of a Learning Mentor, who will provide one-to-one and small group support
- Contribution to the salary costs of an Education Welfare Officer and SAT
- Contribution to the salary costs of all Teaching Assistants to provide focused intervention to small groups of children in all classes (WellComm, Talk Boost, Sign and Shine, Rapid Reading, Direct Phonics, Precision).
- Targeted daily HLTA support for Y6 HAPs in English, Maths and Guided Reading
- Website licenses for Bug Club, Education City, Rapid Reading and Busy Things
- Group interventions and targeted support provided by Teaching Assistants
- Recruitment of two playworkers to support positive play at lunchtimes and encourage social skills
- Daily carton of semi-skimmed milk for Key Stage Two pupils fully funded

Enrichment to raise aspirations

- 'Commando Joe' programme
- Subsidised school visits each term linked to the curriculum.
- Fully funding costs of extra-curricular activities.
- Visits from Steve Smallman (author and illustrator), Ronny Crackers (magician), Marc Griffiths (ventriloquist) and theatre companies throughout the year.
