

## **OMAHA SYSTEM GUIDELINE METADATA: Core Interventions**

**Name of the guideline:**

*Evidence-based Standardized Core Interventions*

**Description:** The purpose of the *Evidence-based Standardized Core Interventions* is to provide a resource of basic and brief interventions for each of the Omaha System problems. Core interventions provide a standard stock of interventions providers can draw upon to guide and document work done with problems outside of a guideline. All 42 Omaha System problems are included. The core interventions came from the interventions available at that time in the Omaha System Guidelines interventions library. Encoders gave special consideration to the most commonly used interventions across all guidelines. The goal is to provide concise, consistent, and generalized interventions, 3 – 7 for each problem that can be used with most any client in the community setting.
