### MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING OF THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF GRAND HAVEN, MICHIGAN SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2014

- 1. The Congregation of the First Presbyterian Church of Grand Haven assembled in God's name on Sunday, February 2nd, 2014 at 9:55 AM, in the sanctuary of the church located at 508 Franklin Street in Grand Haven, Michigan.
- 2. The purpose was for the Annual Congregational Meeting.
- 3. Moderator, The Rev. Dr. Thomas Cook called the meeting to order, determined that a quorum was present at 127, and opened with prayer.
- 4. Motion was made, seconded, and passed for the approval of the published annual reports.
- 5. Treasurer Charlie Parker addressed the congregation and provided a summary of the financial activity for the year. 2013 had been a challenging year, but all of the needs were funded, and we have an excellently-maintained facility. Revenue had been below budget, but expenses were held below budget as well. The budget for the coming year was briefly discussed, with revenue projected at a slight increase and funds utilized from designated funds to cover anticipated shortfall. We are moving forward into the new year with a sense of optimism. Questions were requested from the congregation, and receiving none, motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the Treasurer's report.
- 6. Recently-retired Personnel Chairman Bob VanDyke excused Rev. Tom Cook, Rev. Patricia Locke, and Rev. Scott Robertson from the meeting, and then discussed the terms of call. The details of the compensation are in the annual report. Overall, the proposal is for an increase only for Rev. Robertson, with the others remaining the same. Other expenses such as pension, etc., are assessed by Presbytery and are not within our control. Questions were requested from the congregation, and receiving none, motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the terms of call.
- 7. The Clergy re-entered the room, and Tom asked for any old/new business:
  - a. A question was raised regarding the lack of second-service participants in the congregational meeting and whether or not there had been a direct invitation. The response was that the required multiple announcements had been made at both services, and that there were a fair number of second-service members in attendance.
- 8. The Rev. Dr. Thomas Cook summarized the year, with it having been a tough one but also having had great successes. We've had 80+ members in the Growing in Faith classes, the Children in Worship program now has traction, with parents who had initially been resistant to the program now happy with the changes that they've seen. We're trying in every way to fulfill our mission statement of being a Christ-Centered Community of Acceptance, Growing in Faith, and Living as Christ's Hands to Serve.
- 9. Motion was made, seconded, and approved to adjourn the meeting at 10:11.

#### Treasurer's Report

At \$914,354 revenue was \$40,646 short of budget

Note: revenue includes application of designated funds for operating costs (\$50,783)

At \$953,462 expenses were \$1,598 over budget

Increasing our giving by 10% will create a balanced budget that maintains all of our programs

Mission work totaled \$85,920, or roughly 10% of revenue

New sanctuary roof was paid with capital campaign funds

Upcoming maintenance of exterior of church will be completed in 2015 using Omega funds

Omega fund earnings were taken to help fund the maintenance reserve (\$8,175)

Alpha fund earnings were also taken this year (\$72,239) to offset cost of new programs

We continue to have strong balance sheet

Our facility continues to be maintained in excellent condition

Noteworthy projects completed in 2015:

Handicapped door access and key card system installed with a donation plus Memorial funds

The light, audio and sound systems were upgraded

A security camera system has been installed

A financial review was performed by a group of qualified members for the first time in several years, with only minor suggestions.

A project has been initiated to perform exterior brick maintenance using Omega funds

As always, our goal is to break even. To do this we will need your increased contributions.
