Block Dimensions: Approx. 4" x 6.5" excluding borders

The Basics

This pattern does not include basic instructions for Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP), however, there are many wonderful tutorials online that can be found through a simple online search. If you are a beginner and new to FPP, please do not let this deter you. This pattern is a quick, easy make with few pieces.

When printing this pattern, please be sure to check that your printer settings are set to scale at 100%. A one inch square on the next page may be used reference.

Assembly Instructions

After piecing all sections, attach section A to section B. Next, attach section C to joined sections A and B. Finally, attach section D to joined sections A, B and C. The borders of this block are arbitrary and may be chosen based upon your own preference.

If you wish to match the finished block I created, I used the following measurements: 2" wide borders for the left and right sides of the block, a 1" tall border for the top and a 1.5" border for the bottom.

Personal Sewing Tips

- I've tried various types of FPP paper, and I prefer June Tailor Perfect Piecing Transparent Quilt Block Foundation Sheets. They're transparent enough that you can ensure your fussy cuts are in place, and the paper tears easily once your project is complete.
- Be sure to shorten your stitch length to around 1.5 when paper piecing.
- I recommend tearing out papers after all borders have been attached.
