FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

→ **Trip Schedule:**

- We'll leave on Sunday, July 23 and spend the night at a church between here and Chicago.
- Arrive at Wheaton College for Student Life Missions Camp on Monday, July 24
- Student Life Missions Camp—Mon, July 24-Fri, July 28 at Wheaton, College.
 - Learn more about Student Life Camps at www.studentlife.com
 - We'll go out to site in Chicago area daily for our mission site.
 - They will let us know the details for our exact project as we get closer.
- After checkout, go to Downtown Chicago (Willis Tower/Millennium Park) for sightseeing Fri, July 28
- Spend night at church between Chicago and White Hall on Fri, July 28
- Leave Sat, July 29, for Home and arrive before midnight

→ **Trip Cost:**

- **\$360** Camp Cost (includes all meals/lodging/supplies)
- **\$30** Traveling Meals to Chicago (Lunch Day 1, Supper Day 1, Brunch Day 2)
- **\$40** Traveling Meals from Chicago (Lunch Fri, Supper Fri, Breakfast Sat, Late Lunch Sat)
- \$430** Total Per Person (Note: Students will definitely need to bring additional spending money for Sight-Seeing)

→ **We only have 45 spots for students. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis.**

→ **If spaces fill up, we will establish a waiting list.**

→ **To reserve a spot, you must pay \$100 per spot and turn in Activity Participation Agreement signed by a parent/guardian and the student going to camp.**

→ **Payment Schedule:**

- Sun, Oct 23: \$100 deposit to register
- Wed, Dec 7: \$50 per Camper Payment Due
- Wed, Feb 1: \$50 per Camper Payment Due **/ALL NOTARIZED CAMP FORMS DUE**
- Sun, Mar 5: Youth Day Fundraiser—Students usually get \$75-\$100 each. Amount will vary.
- Wed, Mar 15: \$50 per Camper Payment Due
- Wed, May 3: ALL FINAL CAMP BALANCES ARE DUE
- If you need to work out financial arrangements, please contact Ruth at church office at 870-247-3124. **You can pay ahead of time. You can turn in payments any time. Please make sure to put any camp payments in a labeled FBC Student Ministry Envelope (located outside of Brandon's office at main building and at Sign Up Shack in Game Room).**



- **Fundraiser:** We used to do multiple fundraisers for church trips years ago. But with so many organizations doing fundraisers, we opted several years ago to have ONE BIG fundraiser called Youth Day, where students lead in both services and a second offering is taken. All money collected from second offering on Youth Day is divided up among students signed up for both youth summer camps. Typically, students get around \$75-\$100 towards camp. Amounts vary depending on number of students participating in camps and the total amount of the offering. Youth Day is currently scheduled for Sunday, March 5, 2017.

- **Students have to meet the following requirements in order to get credit for Youth Day:**
 - 1) \$100 deposit paid/Activity Participation Agreement
 - 2) All notarized camp forms turned in by Wed, Feb 1. (We'll mail forms to you.)
 - 3) BOTH \$50 payments for Dec 7 & Feb 1 paid.
 - 4) Participate in BOTH Youth Day services (8:30AM/11AM) on Sunday, March 5, 2017.

- **Cancelations:** ALL DEPOSITS/PAYMENTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE as we cannot guarantee securing another student to take the spot of someone who drops out. The church is also responsible to pay the balance of every spot we secure for camp. If you sign up for a spot, you are still expected to pay the complete balance for that spot even if your teenager drops out.

- **Attendance:** Students who sign up for camp are strongly encouraged to participate in all areas of Student Ministry at FBC: Crosswalk (Wednesdays), Connect (Sunday AM), and 1to1 (Sunday PM). We want the students who attend camps to actually attend church. **Going to summer camp each year without going to church is not the goal of our Student Ministry.**
