



Assistant Professor of Psychology

The Behavioral and Social Sciences department at Southern Arkansas University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in clinical psychology starting August 2017 (January 2017 negotiable). The successful candidate would join a collegial and productive psychology faculty in a highly diverse department and university dedicated to student success.

Duties: Teach four sections per semester in Psychology including General Psychology. Depending on the successful candidate's specialty, courses could include Abnormal, Child & Adolescent, Personality, and Child & Adolescent Development, plus seminars and courses in the applicant's specialty area. Opportunities to teach honors-level courses are available. Tenure-track faculty are also expected to maintain an active program of scholarship, preferably including undergraduate students, and provide service to the department, college, university, and community.

Qualifications: PhD in Clinical Psychology preferred, although ABD will be considered with evidence of degree completion by December, 2017; teaching experience or demonstrated evidence of effective teaching preferred.
