After enjoying the terrain and beautiful scenery of the Western WI countryside, riders make their way to Wilson for an afternoon/evening filled with great people, music and food, and of course, beer, which is brought to you by the LaBrewatory at [Dave's BrewFarm](#) and [Artisanal Imports](#).

This is a family-friendly event that features an art tent with various activities and games for kids, young and old. [Nate Dogs](#) will join us again this year with his food cart filled with delicious hotdogs and a variety of homemade mustards. Vegetarian options are available. Attendees are also encouraged to bring a dish to share – this is a potluck event.

- Bike 68 miles from Hiawatha Cyclery 4301 East 54th St. Minneapolis – Limited to 40 riders. Riders leave Hiawatha at 7:00 a.m. sharp. There will be a number of stops along the way, and a flop wagon will be available. Registered riders starting at Hiawatha Cyclery will receive discounted bike shop services prior to the ride. You'll receive a coupon via email along with your registration confirmation. Bring your potluck items and camping gear to Hiawatha Cyclery and we will haul it out to the BrewFarm for you.
- Bike 30-40 miles around St. Croix and Dunn County – Limited to 25 riders. You'll receive a map of the major cycle routes in the area via email along with your registration confirmation.

- Camp overnight at the BrewFarm. Campsites are rustic and space is limited. Tickets can be purchased for \$20 per adult (kids are no-charge), which includes a campsite, your first glass of beer from the LaBrewatory and breakfast that consists of scrambled eggs, fruit, bread and coffee. Outdoor Porto-potties, potable water and hand washing stations will be available. Modern camping facilities are also available 1.5 miles down the road at [Glen Hills County Park](#).

- Dave's BrewFarm is located at 2470 Wilson, St., Wilson, WI 54027 - GPS: +44° 58' 24.90", -92° 10' 33.06"
- We are on 35 acres of rolling farmland, pastures of tall grasses and wild flowers, woodlands and marsh. There is plenty of space for kids to run free and a number of trails to take a leisurely walk.
- We have honeybee hives on site. If you are allergic to bee stings, prepare accordingly. Further, there is a working produce farm on site, Jake's Burr Oak Farm. Please treat the animals and the gardens with respect. Watch for signs noting areas that are closed to visitors.
