

## KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

**Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles 'doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV**

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

### **Apostles Doctrine**

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

### **Fellowship**

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

### **Breaking of Bread**

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

### **Prayers**

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

## Day 1

### FELLOWSHIP

*(John 8:16 NKJV) 16 And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I am with the Father who sent Me.*

As sons of God we are in the Father. We have fellowship with the Father. Jesus as the Son of God spent time in prayer fellowshiping with the Father. Fellowship is a place of deep covenant to exchange thoughts and conversations. We must have such fellowship with Our Heavenly Father

#### Pray:

- 1.) That your fellowship with the Father would be more consistent
- 2.) For fellowship to reveal the thoughts of the Father to you
- 3.) That you would desire a greater intimacy with the Father

## Day 2

### ALONE

*(John 8:29 NKJV) 29 And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him.”*

We must always live to please the Father so that we are never alone. The Father is always with us. Several people suffer from loneliness and depression because they have not come to know the love of the Father. We must understand that we are not alone because we are in the Father and He is in us.

#### Pray:

- 1.) That you will be confident that you are not alone
- 2.) For those who are lonely and depressed to know the Father's love
- 3.) That you will live to please the Father in all your ways

## Day 3

### TEACHES

*(John 8:28 NKJV) 28 Then Jesus said to them, “ When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things.*

We must speak what we are taught. The Father teaches us through the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit what to say and what to do.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For the Father to teach you all things
- 2.) That you would obey the promptings of the Holy Spirit
- 3.) That you would only speak and do what the Father has taught you

## Day 4

### HONOURS

*(John 8:54 NKJV) 54 Jesus answered, “ If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God.*

Many look to bring honor to themselves. The greatest honor we can receive is when the Father magnifies or glorifies His sons. As sons of the Father when we walk according to His divine will He will honor us.

#### Pray:

- 1.) That you will humble yourself and let God lift you up
- 2.) For honor to be bestowed on whom it is due
- 3.) That as you please the Father He will honor you in due time

## Day 5

### ENVISION

*(John 8:38 NKJV) 38 I speak what I have seen with My Father, and you do what you have seen with your father.”*

Jesus did not speak what He heard but what He saw. We must learn to speak what we see and not just what we hear. When what we hear has become real then we can speak what we see. When the word is flesh then we can see and speak. In Rev 1 the Apostle John turned to see what he heard.

#### Pray

- 1.) For a shift from hearing to seeing the word in your life
- 2.) That you will make the word flesh in all areas of your life
- 3.) That as you fellowship with the Father you will speak what you see

## Day 6

### REVEAL

*(John 8:19 NKJV) 19 Then they said to Him, “Where is Your Father?”*

*Jesus answered, “ You know neither Me nor My Father. If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also.”*

We as the sons of God are on the earth to reveal the Father. Jesus did nothing else as He walked the earth. When people see us they must know the Father's love through us. We must reveal the Father through our lives

#### Pray:

- 1.) For more of the Father to be revealed through your life daily
- 2.) That you would walk closely with the Father so others may know Him
- 3.) That when people know you they would come to know the Father in you
