

KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles 'doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

Apostles Doctrine

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

Fellowship

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

Breaking of Bread

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

Prayers

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

Day 1

COME INTO THE ARK

*(Genesis 7:1 NKJV) 1 Then the Lord said to Noah, “**Come into the ark**, you and all your household, because I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation*

As this generation we must know that the ark is our safe place from the flood. Noah lived in a time of a wicked generation. We are also living in such times and we must know that our safety is Christ who is the ark.

Pray:

- 1.) For this generation to make Christ their safe place
- 2.) That you would reflect Christ to a wicked generation
- 3.) That you would listen to the Noah's of our time

Day 2

HOUSEHOLD

*(Genesis 7:1 NKJV) 1 Then the Lord said to Noah, “Come into the ark, you and all your **household**, because I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation*

A household is a family. A family is part of a generation but also transmits to the next generation. What we do in our families in this generation affects how the next generation will live.

Pray:

- 1.) For families to stay strong in this generation
- 2.) That the word of God would be taught to the next generation
- 3.) For the church as a family to receive God as their Father

Day 3

RIGHTEOUS

*(Genesis 7:1 NKJV) 1 Then the Lord said to Noah, “Come into the ark, you and all your household, because I have seen that you are **righteous** before Me in this generation*

In the midst of wickedness Noah was found to be righteous. Jesus Christ is our righteous standard. Righteousness must prevail in this generation

Pray:

- 1.) For Christ to be the righteous standard in your family
- 2.) That righteousness would be your protection in a wicked generation
- 3.) That God would see your righteousness and bless you

Day 4

NOAH

*(Genesis 5:29 NKJV) 29 And he called his name **Noah**, saying, “This one will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed.”*

Noah means “rest”. In every generation God raises a Noah that would construct a structure that would reflect what that generation could become. When we connect to a Noah we come into rest

Pray:

- 1.) That you would know who is your Noah in this generation
- 2.) For your household to come into rest as you build with a Noah
- 3.) For the Noah's of this time to remain the standard for this generation

Day 5

THIS ONE

*(Genesis 5:29 NKJV) 29 And he called his name Noah, saying, “**This one** will comfort us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed.”*

When Samuel stood in the house of Jesse God told him to anoint “this one”. Noah was the one in his generation that built according to the patterns of God. Christ is the Anointed One. “This one” can only build what the “Anointed One” says.

Pray

- 1.) For the “ones” God has chosen to build in this generation
- 2.) That only Christ the Anointed One would be built
- 3.) For spiritual discernment to know who are the “ones” God has sent

Day 6

COMFORT

*(Genesis 5:29 NKJV) 29 And he called his name Noah, saying, “This one will **comfort** us concerning our work and the toil of our hands, because of the ground which the Lord has cursed.”*

A Noah can shift you from toil to rest. The earth is cursed but when the heart of the father is turned to the son and vice versa then the earth becomes fruitful. We need fathers and sons to connect in this generation to break the curse of the earth.

Pray:

- 1.) For divine spiritual connections that would bring comfort to your toil.
