

KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles 'doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

Apostles Doctrine

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

Fellowship

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

Breaking of Bread

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

Prayers

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

Day 1

ALMIGHTY GOD

(Genesis 17:1 NKJV) 1 When Abram was ninety- nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless

Abram was old when he was introduced to God as "Almighty God" – generation is not defined by age but by how we know God in an age of time. Seasons define who God is for us but we must know Him beyond seasons as Almighty God.

Pray:

- 1.) For this generation to know God and not just about Him
- 2.) That God would be revealed as Almighty God to you and your family
- 3.) For limitations of age to be broken in knowing God more deeply

Day 2

COVENANT

(Genesis 17:2 NKJV) 2 And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly."

We have a generation of covenant breakers. Multiplication only takes place in the confines of a defined covenant. God makes a covenant with Abram and that covenant will be multiplied through Abrams generations. If we keep covenant in this generation then it multiplies in generations that follow.

Pray:

- 1.) That covenants in marriage would be kept strong
- 2.) For covenant within the household of God to be maintained
- 3.) That generations to follow will be covenant keepers

Day 3

FATHER

(Genesis 17:4 NKJV) 4 "As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you, and you shall be a father of many nations.

Fathers determine the continuity of generations. Patriarchal fathers ensure that generations walk in the ways of God. God's covenant with Abram made him a father of many nations. In order for nations to produce generations that will keep covenant we need fathers to arise in these nations.

Pray:

- 1.) For fathers to arise in nations globally
- 2.) That fathers would take their headship roles in families
- 3.) For the Heavenly Father to express His desire through generations

Day 4

NAME CHANGE

(Genesis 17:5 NKJV) 5 No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham; for I have made you a father of many nations.

Name change means a different representation. As Abram he was an exalted father but as Abraham he was a father of nations. This is a shift from self to selfless. This generation is characterized by lovers of themselves and must shift to loving others.

Pray:

- 1.) For a name change to take place in this generation
- 2.) That this generation would be a blessing to others and not lovers of self
- 3.) For this generation to represent God accurately

Day 5

PRODUCE KINGS

(Genesis 17:6 NKJV) 6 I will make you exceedingly fruitful; and I will make nations of you, and kings shall come from you.

When there is a change from "Exalted Father" to "Father of Nations" there is a dominion shift that takes place. Kings rule so that their subjects live well. Christ is King of kings and we by faith in Him are kings unto the Father. This generation must receiving understanding of their kingly mandate

Pray

- 1.) This generation to understand their kingdom dominion mandate
- 2.) For Fathers to empower this generation to become kings
- 3.) That Christ would remain the King of kings in this generation

Day 6

GENERATIONAL COVENANT

(Genesis 17:7 NKJV) 7 And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.

Everlasting life is connected to an everlasting covenant. The life of God comes through a covenant God makes with generations. Jesus lived in the time of an adulterous generation but gave a New Covenant to that generation to become His generation

Pray:

- 1.) For the life of God to be transferred through covenant into this generation
- 2.) That descendents of this generation would walk in covenant with God
- 3.) For your covenant with God to become stronger in your descendents
