

KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

Apostles Doctrine

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

Fellowship

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

Breaking of Bread

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

Prayers

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

Day 1

JOSEPH GENERATION

(Exodus 1:6 NKJV) 6 And Joseph died, all his brothers, and all that generation.

Day 2

Even after the death of Joseph and his brothers the nation of Israel were fruitful and increased abundantly. The next generation must continue to increase and be fruitful after the death of a previous generation. This is multiplication of the values of a previous generation

Pray:

- 1.) That this generation would increase and multiply in morals and ethics like Joseph
- 2.) For this generation to run from Portiphars wife like Joseph
- 3.) That this generation would forgive like Joseph

Day 3

DO NOT KNOW JOSEPH

(Exodus 1:8 NKJV) 8 Now there arose a new king over Egypt, who did not know Joseph.

Egypt is the system of this world and Joseph is a picture of Christ. There are kings in this world that do not know Christ like previous kings. Many presidents of this generation do not believe in God but believe in themselves. Such kings will put the church into slavery and bondage like in the time of Israel in Egypt.

Pray:

- 1.) That this generation will not be influenced by a new world order
- 2.) For this generation to be focused on Christ the King of kings
- 3.) That kings of the earth will bow to King Jesus in this time

Day 4

AFFLICTION TO MULTIPLICATION

(Exodus 1:12 NKJV) 12 But the more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were in dread of the children of Israel.

Israel is a picture of the current church. As they faced affliction so is the church of today. We are afflicted in this generation for our biblical beliefs. Christianity is being criminalized in this generation. We must continue to grow and increase even through this affliction

Pray:

- 1.) For Christians to remain strong and bold in this generation

Day 5

MIDWIVES

(Exodus 1:17 NKJV) 17 But the midwives feared God, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive.

Midwives assist in the birthing process. They represent those that preach the gospel of salvation. Many midwives of our time do not fear God anymore but have fallen prey to the king of Egypt, which is the system of this world. Ministry has become entertainment in this generation.

Pray

Day 6

HOUSEHOLDS

(Exodus 1:20-21 NKJV) 20 Therefore God dealt well with the midwives, and the people multiplied and grew very mighty. 21 And so it was, because the midwives feared God, that He provided households for them

Pray:

- 1.) For this generation to understand the building patterns of God
- 2.) For church to evolve into a family of fathers and sons
- 3.) That households of faith would increase rapidly in all nations
