

KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles 'doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

Apostles Doctrine

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

Fellowship

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

Breaking of Bread

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

Prayers

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

Day 1

GRANTED FAVOR

(Esther 2:17 NKJV) 17 The king loved Esther more than all the other women, and she obtained grace and favor in his sight more than all the virgins

The story of Esther is a picture of the King and the Kingdom. Esther was loved and obtained grace and favor in the sight of the King. We are the Bride of Christ and we are His Queen. We are granted grace and favor in His sight

Pray:

- 1.) That you would be pleasing in the sight of King Jesus
- 2.) For grace and favor to be granted to you in all your endeavors
- 3.) That as His bride you would represent Him well

Day 2

ROYAL CROWN

(Esther 2:17 NKJV) so he set the royal crown upon her head and made her queen instead of Vashti.

Royal crown is the crown of thorns that Jesus wore on His head. This is the mind of Christ that must become our mind. We have the mind of Christ. The mind of Christ is upon His Body and not on any single individual. It is a royal crown or a kingly mindset. We must function with a kingly mindset in this world.

Pray:

- 1.) That you would discover the mind of Christ as you are part of the Body
- 2.) For your mind to reflect the mind of Christ
- 3.) That you would begin to have a kingly mindset

Day 3

APPOINTED AS QUEEN

(Esther 2:17 NKJV) so he set the royal crown upon her head and made her queen instead of Vashti.

Queen Vashti was dethroned and Esther was appointed as Queen. The false queen is being dethroned and the true queen is being established. The house of Saul is getting weaker and the house of David is getting stronger. The true church will arise to power and rule in the midst of her enemies

Pray:

- 1.) For the true church of God to arise globally
- 2.) That the false church will be exposed
- 3.) That the church would reflect her Husband, Jesus Christ

Day 4

CHARGE OF MORDECAI

(Esther 2:20 NKJV) Now Esther had not revealed her family and her people, just as Mordecai had charged her,

Mordecai had charged Esther to hide herself in the courts of the King. We are called to be hidden as the leaven in three measures of meal. Mordecai is a picture of the Holy Spirit that charges us. We need grace to remain hidden and not to expose ourselves.

Pray:

- 1.) That you would remain under the charge of the Holy Spirit
- 2.) For grace to remain hidden until the appointed time
- 3.) For the Holy Spirit to help you in all arrears of your life

Day 5

EQUIPPING GRACE

(Esther 2:20 NKJV) Now Esther had not revealed her family and her people, just as Mordecai had charged her, for Esther obeyed the command of Mordecai as when she was brought up by him.

Esther was brought up by Mordecai. She was nourished, trained and equipped under the guidance of Mordecai. This is an equipping grace that prepares you for Kingdom function. We must sit under such grace to receive grace to function in the Kingdom

Pray

- 1.) That you would be connected to equipping grace
- 2.) For your full potential to be realized in the Kingdom of God
- 3.) That grace will be deposited into your life, as you are equipped.

Day 6

DIVULGE SECRETS

(Esther 2:22 NKJV) So the matter became known to Mordecai, who told Queen Esther, and Esther informed the king in Mordecai's name.

Mordecai divulged secret information to Queen Esther and this saved the king from being killed. The Holy Spirit gives us grace to receive secrets of the Kingdom. There are stewards in the Kingdom that unlock the mysteries of God.

Pray:

- 1.) That you would see the hidden treasure in the word of God
- 2.) For grace to understand God's mysteries
- 3.) For stewards who have been granted access to such mysteries
