

KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles 'doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

Apostles Doctrine

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

Fellowship

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

Breaking of Bread

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

Prayers

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

Day 1

LOOK UP

Gen 15:5

5 Then He brought him outside and said, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them." And He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." NKJV

We are born from above and therefore must receive our perspective from above. Abraham who is the Father of Nations was told to look toward heaven and look at the countless stars. This was to look into limitlessness.

Pray:

- 1.) For your eye to be good so that you will see from the heavens
- 2.) Ask God to change your perspective to His perspective
- 3.) That the earth will not limit you but the heavens will elevate you

Day 2

INVEST IN THE TEMPLE

1 Chron 22:16

16 Of gold and silver and bronze and iron there is no limit. Arise and begin working, and the Lord be with you." NKJV

David wanted to build God a house. God's tabernacle is His people. We are His temple. When we invest in the temple there will be no limit of resources. David saw the provision of God because he was a temple builder.

Pray:

- 1.) That you will discern where to invest
- 2.) For the Church in the City to arise so that all limits can be broken
- 3.) For builders to arise in your city and begin working

Day 3

MASTER CRAFTSMAN

Prov 8:29-30

29 When He assigned to the sea its limit, So that the waters would not transgress His command, When He marked out the foundations of the earth, 30 Then I was beside Him as a master craftsman; NKJV

Christ is the Master Craftsman that knows the limit

Pray:

- 1.) That you would listen to the Master Craftsman who knows the limit
- 2.) Thank God that you are fearfully and wonderfully made

Day 4

INHABITED

Zech 2:4

4 who said to him, "Run, speak to this young man, saying: 'Jerusalem shall be inhabited as towns without walls, because of the multitude of men and livestock in it. NKJV

The New Jerusalem is a church without walls, meaning a church with no limits. This is a church that will ask for nations as their inheritance. This is to have a global perspective of the Kingdom of God

Pray:

- 1.) For your local church to become a church without walls
- 2.) For nations to become our inheritance
- 3.) That you as the church will not be limited by the religion of church

Day 5

TEMPT GOD

PS 78:41

41 Yes, again and again they tempted God, And limited the Holy One of Israel. NKJV
We tempt God by asking Him to provide things that He knows we need. In this way we limit what He really wants to provide through us and not just for us. We limit Him by making need centered prayers rather than praying the Father's will.

Pray:

- 1.) That you would not tempt God and limit His provision
- 2.) For the will of the Father to be enacted through your life
- 3.) That God will provide not just for you but through you

Day 6

SPIRIT WITHOUT MEASURE

John 3:34

34 For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God does not give the Spirit by measure. NKJV

We need the Spirit without measure if we want to be a people that live beyond limits. We must be a people that manifest the sevenfold function of the Spirit of God (Is 11:2)

Pray:

- 1.) Ask the Holy Spirit to come in all His power and live in you
- 2.) That you will be led by the Spirit of God in all you do
- 3.) For the Word to be Spirit and Life in everything you do
