

## KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

***Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles 'doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV***

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

### **Apostles Doctrine**

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

### **Fellowship**

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

### **Breaking of Bread**

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

### **Prayers**

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

## Day 1

### SOWED

Gen 26:12

12 Then Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year a hundredfold; and the Lord blessed him. NKJV

Isaac was living in a land of famine but broke the famine through the principle of sowing. Tithing is not sowing. Tithing is what belongs to God therefore sowing is sacrificial. To sow in famine is sacrifice.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For seed to be released from your hand to break famine
- 2.) That your seed would become sacrificial
- 3.) That your harvest will be abundant

## Day 2

### OVERCOME LACK

Luke 18:22

22 So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, "You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." NKJV

Our distribution causes us to overcome lack. The lack we have is the treasure in heaven. We are God's treasure on the earth but we must know how through sowing to store in heaven

#### Pray:

- 1.) For grace to be a distributor
- 2.) That your distribution will cause you to overcome lack
- 3.) For wisdom to distribute so that you have a heavenly treasure

## Day 3

### WIND OBSERVOR

Eccl 11:4

4 He who observes the wind will not sow, And he who regards the clouds will not reap. NKJV

We sometimes are looking for every excuse not to sow. This stems from fear that you will not receive a harvest. While you observe others are sowing and reaping

#### Pray:

- 1.) That you would not look for excuses not to be a sower
- 2.) That you would overcome the fear to release seed

## Day 4

### INVESTMENT RETURN

2 Cor 9:10

10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, NKJV  
Seed is supplied to a sower, money is held by a miser. You must understand that seed is investment. When you see your money as seed you will receive an investment return

#### Pray:

- 1.) For understanding to see money as seed
- 2.) That you would overcome the fear of money
- 3.) That you would be wise to invest so that the harvest would give you more seed.

## Day 5

### NOT GRUDGINGLY or of NECESSITY

2 Cor 9:7

7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. NKJV

We must release seed cheerfully. The intent must be clean and pure. Our love for God is shown not just in how much we give but with the heart that we give.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For clean heart to sow pure seed
- 2.) That you would become an hilarious giver in the kingdom
- 3.) Thank God for the joy that comes from giving

## Day 6

### GOD IS A GIVER

John 3:16

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. NKJV

The nature of God is to give so that the God kind of life can be experienced. We are created in His image and likeness therefore as the New Creation we are born again givers.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For the God kind of giving to well up in your spirit man
- 2.) That you would give like the New Creation
