

## KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

**Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV**

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

### **Apostles Doctrine**

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

### **Fellowship**

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

### **Breaking of Bread**

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

### **Prayers**

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

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## Day 1

### NO SELF CONTROL

(2 Timothy 3:3 NKJV) 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, **without self-control**, brutal, despisers of good,

Perilous times or a time of being without strength produces a people without self-control. The hallmark of sonship in God is to exercise self-control. The fruit of the spirit is self-control - a mature tree produces fruit. There are several areas in our lives that require self-control.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For maturity in the fruit of self-control
- 2.) That you would exercise self-control to reveal your sonship in God
- 3.) For wisdom to deal with areas in your life where you lack self-control

## Day 2

### NO COMPASSION

(2 Timothy 3:3 NKJV) 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, **without self-control**, **brutal**, despisers of good,

Our media is filled with brutality, fierceness, rage violence etc. People become desensitized to the feelings of others. Violent crime is an indication of perilous times. As children of God we must be compassionate and sensitive to the feelings of others. We can also become hardened in our hearts due to the brutality around us.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For God to intervene in the crime and violence globally
- 2.) That the anger and rage that leads to brutality would be subdued
- 3.) For your heart to be sensitive to the feelings and pain of others

## Day 3

### NO GOODNESS

(2 Timothy 3:3 NKJV) 3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, **without self-control**, **brutal**, **despisers of good**,

People choose to focus more on the evil than the good that is around. Judas despised the good that was done for Jesus. The Pharisees and the scribes despised the good that Jesus did. We carry the spirit of religion when we despise the good that can be done for others.

#### Pray:

- 1.) That you would always celebrate the good that you see in others
- 2.) For the spirit of religiosity to be removed from your life

## Day 4

### NO COMMITMENT

(2 Timothy 3:4 NKJV) 4 **traitors**, **headstrong**, **haughty**, **lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God**,

The world is filled with betrayal. There is a lack of commitment and covenant. People find it easy to betray the trust of others. As Disciples of Christ we must exhibit a high standard of commitment and covenant. This is evidenced by our faithfulness and steadfastness to God's building patterns.

#### Pray:

- 1.) That you will remain faithful and committed to God and His church
- 2.) For marriages to be an example of Christ's love for His church
- 3.) That you would overcome areas in your life where you have been betrayed

## Day 5

### NO OBEDIENCE

(2 Timothy 3:4 NKJV) 4 **traitors**, **headstrong**, **haughty**, **lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God**,

To be headstrong is to be self-willed or habitually disposed to disobedience. We are in a time where we have a generation that is self-willed and refuses wisdom and counsel. Such individuals choose to remain disobedient. As sons of God we live to be obedient to the voice of the Father. We must be headstrong in obedience to His word.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For the word to be a hammer that would destroy the headstrong attitude
- 2.) That you would remain obedient in all things to the Father
- 3.) For those who are headstrong to come to a place of brokenness

## Day 6

### NO HUMILITY

(2 Timothy 3:4 NKJV) 4 **traitors**, **headstrong**, **haughty**, **lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God**,

The world is driven by image and profiling of oneself. This produces high-minded individuals who are disdainful of others. Jesus left us an example of humility and humbleness. As a King He became a bondservant to humanity. God hates pride.

#### Pray:

- 1.) For your life to be one of service to the Kingdom of God
- 2.) For conviction by the Holy Spirit where your heart is haughty
- 3.) That you would be the example that Jesus left for us.
