

KINGDOM CULTURE

The early church believers stood in a culture that brought growth, power and favour upon the church.

Acts 2: 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. 42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. NKJV

This is a kingdom culture that must be developed in every home. It is based on four simple principles:

Apostles Doctrine

This is simply the teaching of God's word in the home on a consistent basis. This doctrine comes from One who is Sent that would lay foundations for growth in the life of the believers.

Fellowship

This is the coming together of the family regularly to fellowship around the doctrine. Fellowship is not merely socializing but it is the discussion of teachings so that it is embedded into the hearts and minds of those fellowshiping

Breaking of Bread

Jesus gave us a New Covenant in His blood and said "do this in remembrance of Me". The practice of the Lord's Table must be carried out daily in the home so that we remember the Lord's death till He returns

Prayers

Prayer is a vital component of maintaining a relationship with God. It is simply conversations that are held with God. Families must pray together and celebrate when God answers their prayers

Day 1

DIVIDES

(Psalms 29:7 NKJV) 7 The voice of the Lord divides the flames of fire.

We all face fiery trials in our life. Like the Hebrew boys who were thrown into the fire for their faith, we as citizens of the Kingdom face similar trials. The voice of the Lord uses trials to hewn or shape us so that Jesus the Son of God appears to others even in our trials. It is His voice that divides or brings understanding of the trials.

Pray:

- 1.) For trials to mature you as a son of God
- 2.) That the voice of the Lord would shape you as a living stone
- 3.) For the flames of your life to reveal more of Christ

Day 2

SHAKES

(Psalms 29:8a NKJV) 8 The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness;

Wilderness is a place of wandering. The Israelites wandered because of rebellion and disobedience. It is the voice of the Lord that shakes wilderness so that we realize our mistakes and come out of a wandering position into a purposeful position. Rebellion to the voice of the Lord will keep us in the wilderness and we will miss the Promised Land.

Pray:

- 1.) That you would not rebel against the voice of the Lord
- 2.) For a shaking by God's voice to take you out of your wilderness
- 3.) For the promises of God to become a reality as you adhere to the voice of the Lord.

Day 3

KADESH

(Psalms 29:8 NKJV) 8 The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness; The Lord shakes the Wilderness of Kadesh.

One of the locations in the wilderness was Meribahkadesh, which means provocation, strife and contention. We stay in the wilderness because of strife and contention. Abraham had to separate from Lot because of strife and contention. The voice of the Lord told Abraham to separate from such relationships, we must do the same.

Pray:

- 1.) For strife and contention to cease in your life
- 2.) That you would separate from non covenantal relationships that bring strife
- 3.) For grace to separate from that which is not of God

Day 4

PRODUCE

(Psalms 29:9a NKJV) 9 The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth

The voice of the Lord makes the womb produce. It causes one to be productive. The deer is known for speed and agility. While we might be busy it will not lead to productiveness. Our speed and agility must be productive for the Kingdom of God. If we are busy for ourselves it will lead to tiredness but when we productive in the Kingdom it leads to rest.

Pray:

- 1.) That God's voice would direct you to make you productive
- 2.) For evaluation of that which is busyness in your life
- 3.) That your productivity would bring you to rest.

Day 5

STRIPS

(Psalms 29:9b NKJV) And strips the forests bare

The word "strips" means to discover. The voice of the Lord causes one to discover honey that is hidden in the tree to energize us. Christ is the tree of life that contains the honey. We must discover the honey that is hidden in Him. A forest is a lonely and scary place that is filled with wild beasts. We need the energy of the word to walk out of the forest.

Pray:

- 1.) For the hidden word to strengthen and energize you
- 2.) That you would receive direction in the forest through the word
- 3.) For the voice of the Lord to help you overcome every wild beast

Day 6

PEACE

(Psalms 29:11 NKJV) 11 The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.

It is the voice of the Lord that strengthens and gives peace. When the benediction is released it is the blessing of the Lord that comes from the voice of the Lord that releases grace, mercy and peace. These are the attributes of Christ that indwell the hearer and make it a reality

Pray:

- 1.) For the voice of the Lord to bring strength and peace into your life
- 2.) That the benediction would unlock the blessing of the Lord over you
