How to Recycle—Place your filled blue bags out for pick-up on the same day as your regular garbage pick-up.

Rinse all containers and throw tops in garbage.

Drop off is always available at NuWay
Recycling 1200 South Division.

Paper may also be dropped off at The Courier News, Broadway and Moultrie.

What to Recycle—Collect in two bags.

One for Plastics (#1 & #2), steel/tin cans, & aluminum

Examples: water and soda bottles, detergent bottles, juice bottles, shampoo bottles, soup cans, tuna cans, soda cans

One for Paper and Cardboard.

Examples: cereal boxes, toothpaste boxes, paper towel and toilet paper inserts, catalogs, magazines, junk mail, newspapers
